#### **GENERAL RULES**

- The participants are required to submit their PowerPoint presentations that contain a minimum of 10 slides and a maximum of 15 slides.
- Each presentation session will be for 1 hour.
- Each presentation session will have 5 participants present in the rooms.
- The content of the PPT should not be copied. Any plagiarism, if detected, will lead to disqualification.
- The Platform for the Virtual Presentation is MS Teams/Google Meet.
- The Maximum time for the Virtual Presentation is 08 minutes.
- Judges will have 10 minutes of Feedback Time
- The participants have to take part individually and not more than 30 participants can register for the competition.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Any student enrolled in either a 5 Year Integrated Law program (B.A. LL.B./B.B.A. LL.B./B.Sc. LL.B. etc.) or a 3 Year LL.B. program at any recognized institution of legal education across India shall be eligible to participate in the competition.



#### **AWARDS & CERTIFICATION**

 All the participants shall be awarded participation certificates.

The Top (05) winners will be decided on the following basis:

- The participant with the highest score out of all the rounds will be declared as Winner and awarded with Rs. 3000 and an Internship opportunity.
- The participant having the second-highest out of all the rounds will be declared 1st Runner Up and awarded with Rs. 1500 and an Internship opportunity.
- The participant who has the third-highest score out of all the rounds will be declared as 2nd Runner Up and awarded with Rs. 1000 and an Internship opportunity.
- The participant who has the fourth and fifth highest score out of all the rounds will be declared as bearing fourth and fifth position.
- The Top 05 entries will also be awarded the certificate of excellence.
- The Top 10 qualifying entries will get a chance to get their PPTs published in an e-compilation, which will be released and launched by the Legal Aid Clinic of School of Law, MUJ.
- The E-Magazine released after the month shall be named WOMXN. Tentative release date- 10th of August, 2021.
