1. The candidate should have obtained his or her degree of Graduation, Post-Graduation, Ph.D. or Equivalent Degree from a recognized Indian University/Institution as approved and recognized by UGC/AICTE/NCTE/NCRTE/PCI etc., or similar statutory councils.
2. The minimum requirement of a consistently 'Good Academic Record' shall be 55% marks (or an Equivalent Grade [Appendix I] in a Point Scale wherever Grading System is followed) at Master's level, and at least 50% marks (or an equivalent grade [Appendix I] in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at Bachelor's Examinations or an Equivalent Degree from an Indian/Foreign University, and Qualifying in the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or similar test accredited by the UGC like GSLET/GSET shall remain in force for the Direct Recruitment for the Post of Assistant Professor in the university.

(OR)

Consistently Good Academic Record shall be an average record of 3rd year (Final Year) Degree & Master Degree Level assessment which would at least be 52.5% or M.Phil or Ph.D. as applicable in case of UGC Regulations.

3. The National Eligibility Test (NET) or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test SLET/SET) [Gujarat State Level Eligibility Test (GSLET/GSET) in the case of the State of Gujarat] shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor (CES) and equivalent positions wherever provided in these Regulations. Further, GSLET/GSET shall be valid as the minimum eligibility for recruitment to Universities/Colleges/Institutions in the respective State only:

Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, or the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or any equivalent position in any University, College or Institution.

Provided further that the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree. All such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only;

- b) The Ph.D. Thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. Viva Voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is published in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in Conferences/Seminars Sponsored/Funded/Supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.
4. NET/SLET/SET shall **NOT** be required for such Master's Degree Programs in Disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET accredited test is **Not** conducted.
 5. A relaxation of 5% marks may be provided from 55 to 50% marks to the Ph.D. degree holder who have obtained their degree prior to 19th September, 1991 for all those positions governed by the UGC Regulations.
 6. The period of time taken by the candidates to acquire M.Phil and or Ph.D. shall not be considered as Teaching/Research Experience to be claimed for the appointment to the teaching positions.
 7. **The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for Direct Recruitment to the Post of Assistant Professor in Universities with effect from 01.07.2021 as per UGC Regulations, 2018.**
 8. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe//Socially and Economically Backward class (SEBC) (Non-Creamy Layer)/ /Differently-abled((a)Blindness and Low Vision; (b)Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotors Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid-Attack Victims and Muscular Dystrophy; (d) Autism, Intellectual Disability, Specific Learning Disability and Mental Illness;(e) Multiple Disabilities from amongst persons under(a)to(d) including Deaf-Blindness) for the purpose of Eligibility and assessing Good Academic Record for Direct Recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an Equivalent Grade [Appendix I] in a Point Scale wherever the Grading System is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
 9. **Consistently "Good Academic Record"** would mean at least 50 % marks in Bachelor's Examinations besides at least 55% marks or an Equivalent Grade [Appendix I] in a Point Scale wherever Grading System is followed at Master's Level in the relevant subject as applicable as per the MSU Ordinance in force and as per the UGC Regulations.

(OR)

Consistently Good Academic Record shall be an average record of 3rd year (Final Year) Degree & Master Degree Level assessment which would at least be 52.5% or M.Phil or Ph.D.

10. Consistently “**Good Academic Record** “in Engineering and Technology would mean, at least First Class (60% marks) or equivalent either in Bachelor’s Degree (B.E./B.Tech.) or Master’s Degree (M.E. / M.Tech) and at least 55% marks or an Equivalent Grade [Appendix I] in a Point Scale wherever Grading System is followed at either Master’s Degree in Engineering /Technology, or at Bachelor’s level where First Class is not obtained by the candidate as applicable as per the MSU Ordinance in force and as per the AICTE Regulations.
11. Equivalence for Ph.D. (AICTE) is based on publication of FIVE International journal papers, each journal having a cumulative impact index of not less than 2.0, with incumbent as the main author and/or FIVE publications being in the authors’ area of specialization as applicable as per AICTE Regulations.
12. Experience at Diploma Institutions is also considered equivalent to experience in degree level Institutions at appropriate level and as applicable. However, qualifications as above shall be mandatory as applicable as per AICTE Regulations.
13. If a class / division is not awarded, minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent to first class / division as applicable as per AICTE Regulations.
14. Fellow of Indian Institute of Management or Institute recognized by AICTE and declared equivalent by AIU shall be considered equivalent to Ph.D.as applicable as per AICTE Regulations.
15. Two years’ full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/ recognized by AICTE / UGC shall be treated equivalent to master’s degree in Management / Administration as applicable as per AICTE Regulations.
16. In case of research experience, good academic record and books / research paper publication / IPR /patents record shall be required as deemed fit by the expert members of the Selection committee. If the experience in industry is considered, the same shall be at managerial level equivalent to head of the Department with active participation record in designing, planning, executing, analyzing, quality control, innovating, training, technical books/ research paper publication / IPR / patents, etc. as deemed fit by the expert members of the Selection Committee as applicable as per the MSU Ordinance in force and relevant statutory regulations as the case may be.
17. The Academic/Research Score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for Universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for Colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview for the Direct Recruitment for the Post of Assistant Professor, Lecturer (in case of Polytechnic) only as Notified and Covered under UGC Regulations 2018.
The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda [MSUB] shall uphold Academic and Educational Standards of the prestigious and renowned university being an ‘A’ Grade Accredited Academic Institution and it shall reserves its right to hold screening test of the candidates from amongst the ‘**Eligible Candidates**’ for the various Teaching and Equivalent Posts as per the respective statutory regulations as applicable taking due consideration of the specified Academic/Research Score as per Appendix-II (Table 3A)

for Universities, if the total number of Eligible Candidates exceeds **thirty times under Each Category separately applicable only in case of teaching Post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer** [In case of Polytechnic] only as notified by the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda [MSUB] for the concerned University Department/ Institute and Constituent College category wise for each of the Notified Category such as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Socially and Economically Backward Category/ People with Different Abilities [PwDs]/ Economically Weaker Section [EWS], and Unreserved [OPEN] Category as the case may be.

18. (a) The Syllabus for setting the question Paper which shall consists of various types of Objective Questions only for holding the Screening Test as mentioned in above Para No. 17 in the Concerned Subject/Discipline under respective applicable category that is for each of the Notified Category such as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Socially and Economically Backward Category/ People with Different Abilities [PwD]/ Economically Weaker Section [EWS], and Unreserved [OPEN] Category as applicable shall be as per Syllabus in force as Notified by the Concerned Agency and Statutory Body/Institute/Council etc. that conducts and notifies the National Eligibility Tests (NET) and various other examinations such as GATE/GPAT etc.
- (b) Over and above with reference to above para vide 18 (a) concerning to The Syllabus for setting the question Paper which shall consists of various types of Objective Questions only for holding the Screening Test as mentioned in above Para No.17 in the Concerned Subject/Discipline under respective applicable category that is for each of the Notified Category such as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Socially and Economically Backward Category/ People with Different Abilities [PwD]/ Economically Weaker Section [EWS], and Unreserved [OPEN] Category as applicable shall be as per Syllabus in force as Notified by the Concerned Agency and Statutory Body/Institute/Council etc. that conducts and notifies the National Eligibility Tests (NET) and various other examinations such as GATE/GPAT etc. shall include “questions having weight age of 10% marks on **‘Contemporary Issues’** in the respective Subject/Discipline over and above notified syllabus for setting question paper of screening test in case of teaching Post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer [In case of Polytechnic] only.
- (c) The criteria for Short listing of Eligible Candidates to be considered and to be called for Personal Interview for the Post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer (in case of Polytechnic) shall be based on considering 50% weight age of Academic Record as per Table A & B as given below and remaining 50% weight age shall be considered based on performance of the candidate in the Screening Test as mentioned in para 18 (a) and (b) to be held by the University as the case may be.

19. The Syllabus for the Screening Test as mentioned in above para for the concerned subject/discipline shall be the Syllabus in force as notified by the concerned agency and statutory body/institute/council etc. which conducts and notifies the National Eligibility Tests such as NET/GATE/GPAT etc.
20. The candidate shall be required to appear in the screening test in the respective subject/discipline considering his or her eligibility for the Post of Assistant Professor as the case may be.
21. The Syllabus for the Screening Test for those Subjects/disciplines shall be determined and notified by the university for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
22. The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda would display the application numbers of eligible candidates 'Category Wise Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe(ST)/Socially and Economically Backward class(SEBC) / Persons with Different Abilities(PwDs)/Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)/ Unreserved (UR or Open Category) from amongst the short-listed Candidates to be called for the personal interview to fill in the Post of Assistant Professor on the Website of the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda and an intimation via e-mail shall also be sent to each of these candidates.
23. The Selection Committee may recommend the suitable candidate based on the merit list prepared taking into consideration Educational Qualifications, Experience, Research Aptitude, Presentation (Optional) etc. and performance of the candidate in the Personal Interview.
24. Any subsequent Change/Modification/Alteration/Addition in the Issued Original First Notification shall be displayed only on the Website of the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda.
25. In case if any candidate wishes to make Submission/ Representation for his or her own candidature in lieu of his/her Academic/Research Score as specified in Appendix II(Table 3A) as calculated and displayed on the website of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, S/he shall be required to make in person written submission and or representation with supporting verifiable documentary evidences, documents etc. within seven working days to the competent authorities of the university without fail.
26. The decision of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda shall be final and abide to all concerned and in case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction in force shall be Vadodara, Gujarat State only.
27. Grade point which is on a scale of seven, mechanism in Appendix I shall be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage.

28. Those applicants who have earlier submitted application for the Post of the Assistant Professor under CES in response to Notification No.ADE 3/4/2020-2021 dated 2-11-2020 are not required to apply afresh, however, he/she can submit additional information, if any.
