

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR RESEARCH & DATA ANALYSIS ON POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2012)

National Law University Delhi through the Centre for Child Rights & Juvenile Justice is undertaking a research project with the support of UNICEF for which it invites applications for the following positions:

- 1. Research Associate (up to 2 positions)
- 2. Data Analyst/Statistician (up to 2 positions)

This is a 4 month project, involving analysis of judicial data on POCSO cases, drafting a report on the findings, along with undertaking other allied tasks. The project is a study of 10 years of POCSO, and draws data from 8 states on various aspects of disposal of POCSO cases. The project will culminate in a research report to be released in December 2022, and may further be converted into deeper research projects and/or academic publications.

Qualifications & Compensation:

- A. Graduate with a degree in law and 0-2 years experience.
- B. Familiarity with criminal law and the Indian criminal justice system is a strong requirement.
- C. Remuneration is competitive and will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Application Process: Interested persons may send their résumé and a brief statement outlining the likely contributions to our work. The statement of purpose must not exceed 750 words. For selected candidates, evidence of academic and professional qualifications, as well as identity proof, will be required to be shown at the time of signing the contract.

Deadline: Applications must reach us no later than midnight of August 7th. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

Shortlisted candidates shall be informed about the next round in the selection process via email.
