

NHRC Human Rights Photography Competition 2022

Terms & Conditions

- 1. There is no entry fee to participate in the contest which is open to Indian citizens only.
- 2. Only Indian Citizens aged 14 years and above can participate.
- 3. Any individual who desires to participate will be required to provide his/her name, date of birth, correspondence address, email address and mobile number.
- 4. Bank details will be required to be submitted by the winners after announcement of the result of the competition. Non-furnishing of the above information/documents at appropriate stage will render the selection null and void.
- 5. Photos should be originally shot by the applicant and if these are found to be infringing copyright, these will be rejected.
- 6. The photos should not be on display on Social Media Sites or on any publication.
- 7. The Photographs should be shot in HD Standard having pixel size of 3600x5400 and an aspect ratio of 3:2.
- 8. The submission will be through MyGov Portal.
- 9. In case of selection of the photographs for awards, the applicants will be required to send a Glossy hard print of the same in 18x24 inches.
- 10. The MyGov profile of the participant should be accurate and updated as well as the information on the profile for further communication. This includes the participant's name, photo, e-mail ID, mobile number and Aadhar number. Entries of participant/applicant who fail to furnish complete profile may be rejected.
- 11. NHRC, India has the right to cancel or amend all or any part of this Contest and/ or the Terms& Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria. However, any changes to the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/ posted on the MyGov platform. It would be the responsibility of the participants/applicants to keep themselves informed about any changes in the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria stated for this contest.
- 12. The NHRC, India will have the right to use the photographs including uploading these on its website/social media for awareness purposes, as it may deem fit.
