INVITATION FOR YOUNG PROFESSIONAL FELLOWS

Background

The Department provides a unique opportunity for young professionals interested in development sector to gain first-hand experience of working in Government Departments and their field offices and directly contribute towards making change at scale. Therefore, we are hiring Young Professional Fellows with a passion for improving government performance and resolving social problems.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The responsibilities would vary from project to project and would majorly frequently include:

1. Assist in making policies and programs
2. Identifying bottlenecks in government schemes and suggest reforms through research on best practices.
3. Providing innovative and feasible yet high impact solutions to identified challenges.
4. Assisting department to brainstorm and identify solutions to produce meaningful change.
5. Identifying expert agencies and institutions for building knowledge partnerships and technical collaboration.
6. Providing information technology, social media marketing, project management, data analytics and legal support for the effective functioning of the Department and its field offices.

Preferred Skills:

- 1) Improving government performance and solving problems related to skilling, employment, livelihood generation, entrepreneurship, and innovation.
- 2) Self-motivated with an orientation towards results.
- 3) Excellent written and verbal communications.
- 4) Strong project management capabilities.
- 5) Sound quantitative and analytical skills, with experience generating and using data to drive insights and communicating those insights to others.

- 6) Ability to navigate complex organizations, develop trust with senior leaders, and build relationships among diverse groups of stakeholders.
- 7) Awareness and sensitivity to the needs and concerns of individuals from diverse cultures, backgrounds, and orientations, and ability to apply that to their work.
- 8) Willingness to travel is required.
- 9) Proficiency in Marathi will be added advantage.

Preferred Qualification:

- A Graduate or Masters (pursuing or completed) in fields like Economics/Public Policy/Management/ Engineering/Mathematics/Computer Science/ Information Technology/ Data Management/ Sales / HR / Media - Journalism / Communication / Literature & allied disciplines along with strong IT and presentation skills.
- Experience in skilling, livelihoods, entrepreneurship, employment, start-ups, incubators, digital marketing, field work, human resources & admin, media, communications or public relations, and proficiency in documentation would be an added advantage.
- Excellent verbal, written, interpersonal skills, good time management & organizational skills.
- The candidates must be proficient in Microsoft office, data analytics, data visualization software, etc.
- **For media & communication fellows**, digital marketing expertise, content management systems, social media platforms, graphic designing (Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe InDesign, Illustrator, Corel Draw, Crello, Canva, etc.) is desirable which will help in dissemination of initiatives and through print & digital media.

Deployment of Young Professional Fellows:

- The shortlisted candidates would be operating from Mumbai under the guidance of Principal Secretary, Department of Skills, Employment, Entrepreneurship and Innovation and Commissioner, Skills, Employment, Entrepreneurship, and Innovation. - Candidates should provide two Letter of recommendations from previous employers and / or alma mater with their contact details.
- Duration of the Fellowship shall be for a period of 2 years from the date of joining, subject to performance review, the candidate may get an extension for another year.
- **Remuneration:** The salary bracket offered YP Fellows shall be in the range of Rs 40,000 to 50,000/- depending on qualification and experience of the candidate.
- Travel cost for official work outside Mumbai will be borne by the office.
- Certificates will be given to Young Professional Fellows on satisfactory completion of fellowship period of 2 years.

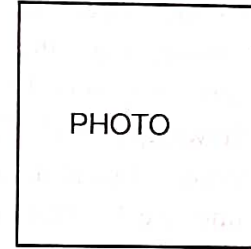
