BATNA for each party in Mediation.

7. How to negotiate with the parties, techniques of negotiation, effective questioning and listening International Negotiations and Bargaining like in UN

8. Practical Session on **Opening Statement** (how to draft and deliver opening statement)

10. Why Mediation as a dispute resolution mechanism? Role of lawyers in Mediation; Court annexed Mediation; Mediation in workplace; Mediation in family disputes

How to be a good Mediator?** (The qualities required, what a Mediator should do, how to carry forward the dialogue between two parties, how to communicate, opening statement of Mediator) building rapport with the parties and how to communicate with the parties. The art of effective questioning as a Mediator.
