




DR. DURGAMBINI PATEL

Selection of papers for presentation will be based on abstracts. An abstract must include a clear indication of the purpose of research, methodology, major results, implications and key references. SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Final Paper Should Adhere the Following Guidelines:

- Format of file Microsoft Word (Docx) or (Doc)
- Font Times New Roman
- Font Size 12 (Text), 10 (Footnote)
- · Margins One-inch margin on all sides
- Line spacing 1.5 (Text), Single (Footnote)
- · Citation Style: Bluebook 20th Edition
- Word Limit: Abstract 350 words; Full Paper 3000-8000 words (excluding footnotes).
- Language UK English only.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Submissions will pass through blind peer review and acceptance will be subject to the report of the peer review team. Submissions not meeting the requirements mentioned will not be reviewed.
- The final paper should be submitted after the intimation of acceptance of abstract.
- The final submission shall be concluded within the prescribed deadline.
- No abstract or full paper shall be accepted after the last dates of submission, respectively.
- Paper Presenters have to register after the acceptance of abstract with payment of required fees.
- For participation, registration is mandatory on confirmation of the participation.

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All submissions must be original and unpublished work of the author/s and should not have been submitted, accepted or published elsewhere.
- Co-authorship of entries (maximum two) among individuals from the same or different institutions is allowed. Multiple entries by the same authors are not allowed.
- The Editorial Board reserves the rights to accept and reject the submissions at any stage of the review. The decision of the organizers regarding selection of the papers shall be final.
- The copyright for all entries shall vest with the organizers who herewith reserve the right to modify the contributions as per the requirements of necessity
- There shall be a Zero tolerance policy on Plagiarism and Copyright. Similarity up to 15% is permissible.

- All the final submissions shall be subjected to blind peer review and plagiarism check, subsequent to which the selected papers will be considered for publication with Taxmann.


