LEGAL AID CLINIC AND MEDIATION CENTER, GALGOTIAS UNIVERSITY

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Deepak Mishra (Former Chief Justice of India) inaugurated the Legal Aid Clinic at School of Law Galgotias University on April 26, 2014. The Legal Aid Clinic has been set up in collaboration with the District Legal Service Authority, Gautam Buddha Nagar in order to give effect to the policy and directions of the National Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 and the National Legal Services Authority (Legal Aid Clinics) Scheme, 2010. The School of Law, Galgotias University established the Students Legal Aid Clinic to provide free legal aid to the poor, needy persons and the members of the weaker sections of the

society. The Clinic has conducted legal awareness programs among people particularly illiterates and economically weaker section of the community, living in remote backward areas near the Law School and has created awareness about their legal rights and duties and to make them aware of the

Mediation Center was established with the vision of developing and training students in alternative methods of dispute resolution and reducing the burden of courts in India. Mediation cell facilitate dispute resolution in a timely manner with no cost. Students learn the alternative ways of access to justice system and enhance their practical skills of mediation.

The mediation center was inaugurated by Hon'ble Dr. Justice KJ Thaker, Judge, High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, in esteemed presence of Justice (Retd.) JR Midha and Mr. Rajeev K. Virmani, Senior Advocate, on 3rd September, 2022.

ABOUT DLSA

District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) in India is a part of the Legal Services Authorities Act 1987. It is responsible for providing free and competent legal services to the weaker sections of society, ensuring that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen due to economic or other disabilities. Each district in India has a DLSA. The DLSA is headed by the District Judge of the respective district who is the ex-officio Chairman.

The key functions of the DLSA include:

- 1. Organizing Lok Adalats:** Lok Adalats are court-like alternative dispute resolution (ADR) mechanisms. They are tasked with settling disputes through conciliation and compromise. The decision of the Lok Adalat is deemed to be a decree of a civil court and is final and binding on all parties.
- 2. Legal Aid and Advice:** The DLSA provides free legal services to eligible candidates (those who fulfill certain criteria based on income, caste, etc.). This includes providing a lawyer to represent the eligible person in legal proceedings.
- 3. Promoting Legal Awareness:** The DLSA often organizes legal awareness programs to educate the general public about their rights and duties, and how the legal system can assist them.
- 4. Implementing various schemes,** as per the direction of the Central Authority (National Legal Services Authority - NALSA) and the State Authority (State Legal Services Authority - SLSA). In addition to these, DLSA has other functions and responsibilities to ensure that justice is accessible to all. The goal of these authorities is to ensure that the legal system promotes justice

ABOUT PRO BONO LEGAL SERVICES PROGRAMME

Pro Bono Legal services programme was launched in April 2017. An initiative of the Department of Justice, the programme is aimed at fulfilling the Department's critical mandate of enhancing "access to justice" for marginalised sections of the society and the State's constitutional obligation of providing "free legal aid" for all. OBJECTIVE

Under the theme of “**VasudhaivaKutumbakam**” or “One Earth, One Family, One Future,” India aims to prioritize inclusive economic growth and sustainable development. India’s G20 Presidency seeks to explore strategies and policies that drive economic growth while ensuring social inclusivity and environmental sustainability.

With the idea of spreading legal awareness and unity in the society, The School of Law, Galgotias University is organizing this National Event on the theme of “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam”, 'The World is One Family'.

We as a Citizen of this country recognizes the importance of addressing income inequality, poverty eradication, and promoting sustainable practices. So, we request you to ensure your participation in this event by spreading awareness to the society with a motive of its sustainable and equal growth.

Rules and Regulations

1. GENERAL

1.1.Composition of Team

Each team may comprise of maximum Fifteen (15) members & minimum five (5) This number cannot be modified under any circumstances.

1.2.Eligibility

The competition is open for students pursuing 3 year or 5 year LL.B or LL.M, from any University approved by the Bar Council of India. No cross-university team shall be allowed to participate. Only one team per university may register.

1.3.Date and Venue

The Competition shall take place on **26th AUGUST 2023**. The Competition will take place in physical mode at School of Law, Galgotias University.

1.4.Language

The language of the Competition shall only be English or Hindi.

1.5.Dress Code

According to theplay’s theme.

2. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

2.1 The competition shall take place in two phases. In the first phase; interested teams must submit a copy of their performance in a video form in the google link provided on emails after the last date of registration i.e. 05.08.2023.

The videos for the purpose of scrutiny will have to be submitted latest by 15.08.2023 on the said link. No late submissions will be entertained in any circumstances.

2.2 All teams submitting their videos will get an E-certificate of participation.

2.3 Top 5 teams based on highest score shall proceed to the next phase which shall take place Physically at Galgotias University campus.

2.4 In the physical round, all participants must report at the venue at least 2 hours prior to the commencement of the event. The script and performance should adhere to the theme of the event (Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam). All participants shall be required to carry their Institute's ID Cards which they will be required to present at the registration desk before the commencement of the event. And only registered people are allowed to take part in the event.

2.5 Each team will be given 15 minutes to present their street play. First warning bell will be given after 10 mins and final warning bell after 15 mins. There will be negative marking if teams exceed the performance time.

2.6 Teams using any props must bring all their requirements and must be ready well in time as per instructions of the organizer. No Props or any material will be provided by the host university. Teams should remove all the props and set items if used any.

2.7 Teams must arrange their own travel and accommodation. No travel/accommodation allowances will be provided by the host university.

2.8 The Competition will be conducted on a "ground" like (open place) and hence no microphones, Speakers, Music systems will be allowed or available. Teams can sing / dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.

2.9 Team with the highest aggregatescore shall be declared as the winner, team with the second highest aggregate score shall be declared as the first runner up, team with the third highest score shall be declared as the second runners up.

3. REGISTRATIONS

3.1 All interested teams must register themselves by filling the following form: -

3.2. The last date for registration shall be 5th August 2023.

3.3. Street play script should be submitted latest by 10th August 11:59 pm. Script Should Be Submitted on the MailID: -gustreetplay2023@gmail.com with Subject "Street play Script".

3.4. Please note: The host university will allow a maximum of 30 teams only on first come first basis.

3.5. Selected teams shall receive a team code, which shall be used for further communications.

4. MARKING CRITERIA

Out of 100, marks will be allocated on the following basis:

4.1. Script: -20 Marks

4.2. Performance in acting (dialogue delivery, expressions and body language, co-ordination between members): -40 Marks

4.3. Outfit & stage coverage: - 20 Marks

4.4. Time Management & Usage of Props: - 20 Marks

5. AWARDS

The following awards shall be given: -

5.1. Best Team: - Cash Prize of Rs 20,000+ Certificate of Merit.

5.2. First Runner Up Team: Rs 15,000 + Certificate of Merit.

5.3. Second Runner Up Team: Rs 10,000+ Certificate of Merit.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

6.1. Decision of Judges will be final and binding on all teams and no objections shall be entertained.

6.2. College name shall not be disclosed at any stage. Disclosure/indication of college identity will result in direct disqualification.

6.3. Teams should have decency and decorum in the behavior, attire and performance.

6.4. In case of Abusive language and indecent behavior, the team will be disqualified.

6.5. Any kind of fluids, live animals, flames, heavy objects, colors or any other material which has a possibility of damaging the venue is STRICTLY prohibited. If any such practice is conducted by the participants, the team will be disqualified.

6.6. Obscenity and statements affecting religious sentiments of any kind is not allowed and may lead to disqualification.
