The Group of 20 ('G20') is an intergovernmental organization which promotes economic cooperation among premium nations across the world. Its members account for over two-thirds of the earth's population and over 75% of the global trade. It does not have a charter or a secretariat. The G20 Summit is led by the Sherpas of its member, i.e., the personal emissaries of their leaders. The Sherpas oversee negotiations throughout year, discussing agenda items for the Summit and coordinating its substantive work.



## SIGNIFICANCE OF INDIA'S G20 PRESIDENCY

On the 16<sup>th</sup> of November, 2022, the President of Indonesia Mr. Joko Widodo officially handed over the Presidency for the 18<sup>th</sup> G20 Summit to the Prime Minister of India, Shri. Narendra Modi. During this period, there will be over 200 meetings in about 50 cities across a myriad of workstreams, all backed by an objective to showcase India to the rest of the world as a prominent leader on the global front.
