Detailed Criteria for Eligibility along with desirable Qualification

1. Professor(Law)

Essential Qualification:-

- A. (i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in UGC CARE/SCOPUS listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria prescribed by the UGC.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

- B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' teaching experience.

2. Associate Professor(Law)

Essential Qualification:-

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines with relevance to the post advertised along with teaching experience and who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned area of specialized subject with relevance to the post advertised;
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in UGC CARE/SCOPUS listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five (75) as per the criteria prescribed by UGC.



3. Assistant Professor (Law)

Essential Qualification:-

A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions : -

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

OR

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

A relaxation of 5% will be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility.

Desirable Qualification:-

A research experience with relevance to the post advertised along with teaching experience and who has SCOPUS listed publications in the concerned area.;

Explanation – Teaching Experience will be counted if the candidate hold any whole time post U.G.C. scale of pay designated as Assistant Professor against a substantive post and not in ad-hoc basis.



Notes

(1) Photo-copies of the certificates, mark-sheets, testimonials etc. should be attached with the application (self-attested) and the originals must be produced at the time of interview and at the time of joining, if selected. (2) Except where otherwise indicated, applicants appearing for the interview shall do so at their own expense. (3) University reserves the right not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised if the circumstances so warrant. (4) University reserves the right to consider candidates of outstanding merit who may not have applied. (5) Relaxation of any of the qualifications may be made in exceptional cases on the recommendation of the selection committee. (6) Separate application is required for each post. (7) A candidate claiming to be S.C./S.T./O.B.C. must have a certificate in support of his/her claim from a competent authority of West Bengal as specified below [vide the West Bengal SCs and STs (Identification) Act, 1994 and SCs /STs Welfare Department order No. 261-TW/EC/MR-103/94 dated with B.C.W. Deptt. Order No. 6320-BCH/MR-84/10 dated 24.09.2010]. In the District, the Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub-Division concerned, and In Kolkata, District Welfare Officer, Kolkata & ex-officio Jt. Director, Backward Classes Welfare Deptt., Govt. of West Bengal [No.2420-BCW/MR-61/2012 (Pt.) dated 12.07.13. (8) Academic Qualification is as per UGC guidelines. DA, HRA, Transport Allowance at Central Govt. rates applicable in Kolkata and CPF. (9) Persons in employment should route their application through proper channel. (10) Application should be sent through the present employers, if employed. (11) University being a residential campus, the teaching staff, if appointed may be required to stay on campus. This is subject to the availability of accommodation. (12) Eligibility of a candidate and satisfaction of any short-listing criteria shall be considered as on the last date of the receipt for application. (13) Candidates if selected for appointment in field of law and Computer Science shall have to teach any subjects in the field of law and Computer Science as and when asked by the authority. (14) All addresses required in the application form should be written in block letters and should give full details including the Pin Code. Where possible, mention Mobile/telephone numbers and area code. (15) The application form should be complete in all respects. Incomplete applications will not be considered and no correspondence entertained. (16) No TA/DA for attending the interview would be provided (17) If the space against any item is inadequate, applicants are free to furnish the relevant particulars on separate sheets, indicating therein, and the item number to which the information relates. (18) Candidates applying for teaching posts are required to submit copies of Articles/Papers with relevant proof as the case may be. (19) Pay Protection and Career Advancement Scheme under the UGC Regulation will be applicable for the above positions. (20) Specialization will be based on Ph.D/ Master's Degree /Research Publication carried out by the candidate. (21) No claim for being a member of the SC, ST and OBC shall be entertained after submission of the application.
