

**Submission Guidelines:** To ensure a smooth submission process, please follow these guidelines when submitting your contributions:

- 1. All contribution must be submitted electronically.
- 2. Your submission must be related to the seminar theme/sub-themes.
- 3. The abstract should be between 250-300 words and with minimum five keywords.
- **4.** The abstract shall also contain, the name of the author/authors, email id of the authors, contact number, and designation with affiliated institution.
- 5. The full paper should not exceed 6000 words (Abstract is not included).
- 6. Paragraphs should be double spaced.
- 7. The font should be Times New Roman with a size of 12 on A4 size plain paper with one inch margin on all sides with 1.5 line spacing using MS Word.
- 8. Heading and Sub-heading should be size 14 and 12 respectively.
- 9. Footnote should be in font size 10 in Times New Roman.
- **10.** For citation and references, the Indian law Institute citation style must follow. For details you can visit on (<u>https://www.ili.ac.in/cstyle.pdf</u>)
- **11.** Abstract should be emailed to <u>vasudevactivity@gmail.com</u> as well as upload to the registration form mentioned above. Full paper should be emailed to the same email id.
