ESSENTIAL ELIGIBILITY

- 1. For Assistant Professor a good academic record:
 - o with a **PhD Degree** in the concerned /allied/relevant disciplines or
 - a Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) with UGC-NET/JRF/SET.
 - o candidates with 2-3 years' experience are preferred.

- 2. For Associate Professor a good academic record:
 - o with a **mandatory PhD Degree** in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines
 - a Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) with UGC-NET/JRF/SET.
 - o additionally require a minimum of 8 years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals.
- 3. For Principal, a good academic record:
 - o with a **mandatory PhD Degree** in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline;
 - Professor/Associate Professor with a total service/ experience of 15 years
 of teaching/research/ administration in Universities, Colleges and other
 institutions of higher education;
 - o A minimum of 120 Academic/Research Score as per Assessment criteria and methodology prescribed under UGC Regulations, 2018.

Provided, the candidates registered for the PhD programme prior to July 11, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/ SLET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions.

- ➤ The PhD degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- The PhD thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- ➤ An open PhD viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- ➤ The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her PhD work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- ➤ The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/ CSR or any similar agency

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the university concerned.
