CALL FOR PAPERS

The Conference invites research papers that delve into various facets of the overarching theme, 'Tracing Human Rights in Diversifying Society: A Global Perspective.' Participants are encouraged to explore topics aligned with this central theme, and while not limited to these areas.

- 3 Human Rights of Migrants, Refugees etc
- 4 Human Rights in Armed Conflict Zones
- 5 Nonkilling and Human Rights
- 6 Human Rights and Criminal Justice System
- 7 Environmental Justice, Indigenous Communities, and Self Determination Rights
- 8 Human Rights vis-a-vis Infrastructural laws, Energy Laws and Corporate Laws
- 9 Human Rights and Pandemic Response: Equity and Global Health
- 10 Human rights and Gender Equality
- 11 LGBTQ+ Rights and National Identity: A Cross-Cultural Examination
- 12 Women's Rights Amid Conflict: Health, Identity, Representation
- 13 Cultural Diversity and Issues of Human Rights

The listed themes are merely indicative, the candidates are free to choose any other subject resonating with the concept of Human Rights and Constitutional Values.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. LANGUAGE

The language of the conference shall be English.

2. DEFINITIONS

- “The Conference” means The International Conference on “Tracing Human Rights in Diversifying Society: A Global Perspective”
- “JLU CCLHR” means the JLU Centre for Constitutional Law and Human Rights.
- “Identity” means any fact of the identity of an individual/a team/its members, or the College/University/Organisation represented by the individual/team and the state or region where such College/University/Organisation is located and includes any identification marks/ seal of the individual/team or the College/University/Organisation represented.
- “Organizing Committee” or “OC” refers to the organisers of the conference & members of the JLU CCLHR.
- “Paper” means an unpublished, original manuscript for the purpose of this Conference.
- “Participant” means a candidate submitting a paper but not presenting.
- “Presenter” means a candidate submitting and presenting a paper.
- “Team” means the structured unit of the registered participant(s)/presenter(s) of the Competition. Each team shall consist of one individual or two individuals that meet the eligibility criteria.
- “University” means Jagran Lakecity University, Bhopal.

3. INTERPRETATION

The Centre will have exclusive authority to interpret the Rules in the interest of fairness and equality. The interpretation placed upon these Rules by the Organizing Committee shall be conclusive and the decision of the OC regarding the application of these rules shall be final.

4. ELIGIBILITY

Author(s) must be:

- Students (Law or related discipline), or,
- Academician/professor in law or related discipline, or,

- Legal researcher, or,
- Lawyer and/,
- Other scholars in related disciplines of research and training, to be eligible to participate in the Conference.

Note: The conference allows the participation of a cross-institution team.

5. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

5.1. Author(s) must provisionally register by filling the registration form, and submitting the abstract by or before 5th February, 2024.

5.2. After acceptance of the Abstract, of which the candidate(s) shall be intimated through email by 12th February 2024, the team shall make the complete registration by paying the registration fee on or before 16th February, 2024. Please find the payment related information on point 6.

Note: Please note that the registration process will be considered complete upon payment of the registration fee.

5.3. Registration fee

For Presenters -

- Research Scholars & Students (Sole Authorship): INR 500
- Research Scholars & Students (Co-Authorship): INR 400 per author
- Academicians & Legal Professionals: INR 1000
- Academicians & Legal Professionals (Co-Authorship): INR 800 per author
- For JLU Students (Sole & Co- Authorship): INR 500

For Participants -

- Research Scholars & Students: INR 200
- Academicians & Legal Professionals: INR 500

Note:

- Candidates presenting at the university premises shall bear their own travel and accommodation expenses.
- The University shall charge INR 1600 per day in case the candidates presenting at the university premises seek its assistance for accommodation purposes.

7. GENERAL RULES

- Co-authorship is allowed up to a maximum of two authors.
- The manuscript must be an original and unpublished work of the author(s) and any form of plagiarism beyond 25% shall lead to disqualification.
- The author(s) has to give a declaration of the originality of the work.
- Author(s) shall be solely responsible for the accuracy of statements, opinions and views presented in the manuscripts.

8. GUIDELINES

8.1. Abstract

- Word limit: 500 words.
- Author(s) should mention the following details on the front page of the file containing the abstract:
 - (i) Name of the Author(s),
 - (ii) Affiliation,
 - (iii) Designation,
 - (iv) Contact Number,
 - (v) Email ID,
 - (vi) Title of the Submission
 - (vii) Keywords

- Font & Font Size: Times New Roman, 12; Line spacing: 1.5; Alignment: 'justify'
- Submissions must be made in MS Word Format (.doc)/(.docx) only.

8.2. Final Manuscript

- Length of full paper: Maximum 3500-7000 words (excluding footnotes)
- Font and Font Size: Times New Roman, 12; Line spacing 1.5; and Alignment: 'justify'.
- Submissions must be made in MS Word Format (.doc)/(.docx) only.
- Submissions made in any other format shall not be considered.

Note:

- The author should maintain anonymity throughout in the manuscript.

8.3. Footnotes & Citations

- Font type: Times New Roman; Font Size: 10; line spacing 1.
- The citations must conform to the Bluebook 21st edition/Harvard citation.
- It is not permitted to provide any information in the footnotes that is not related to the identification of an authority or source. Footnotes must not include additional legal arguments.
- Endnotes are not permitted.

9. SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All submissions must be made in the English language only.

9.1. Abstract:

- File name of abstract submission shall adhere to the style 'Abstract: First name of the Author ICTHR'
- The author(s) must submit the abstract via the registration form (point 5.1.) on or before 5th February, 2024.
- Acceptance of the abstract shall be communicated by 12th February, 2024.

9.2. Final Manuscript

- The submission of the final manuscript is to be made via Google form for submission on or before 4th March, 2024.

- File name for the Final Manuscript submission shall adhere to the style “Title of the Paper ICTHR”
- No alteration would be entertained in the final submission once made.
- The paper then has to be presented in front of the panel (in case of a presenter) at the Conference dated 6-7 March, 2024.
