- All submissions must be in Times New Roman, Main Content- font size 14, Heading- font size 16, Footnoting 11, spacing 1.5, Margins: Left 1 Inch, Right 1 Inch, Top 1 Inch, and Bottom 1 Inch.
- Footnoting and Citations must strictly conform to the standards laid down by ILI.
- The submitted work must adhere to the general rules, and the author(s) are solely responsible for the correctness of any facts, opinions or viewpoints expressed in it. The language employed must not be derogatory or result in disrepute of any individual.
- The Editor does not accept plagiarized content and in case of gross plagiarism found in the contents of the submitted manuscript, the manuscript shall be subject to rejection.
