It not only featured many firsts of the women's accomplishments but also etched a name for them in many areas hitherto dominated by men. Appointment of the Indian Navy's first female commanding officer of a naval ship and the appointment of Disha Naik as India's first female airport fireman hold testimony to this. Numerous women have also been recognized through Padma Awards in the year 2023-2024 for their noteworthy contribution to the field of art, public affairs and social service. The long list of awardees is decorated by the names of extraordinary figures like Vjyayantimala Bali, Sudha Murti, Usha Uthup and M Fathima Beevi. The list of achievers is endless so let us celebrate a few of the many inspirational women, listed below, who lighted the path for the millions to follow through their hard work and determination:

Claudia Goldin became the first solo woman awardee of the Nobel Prize in Economics. Her outstanding work was also dedicated to women, assessing their contribution to the economy over the past century and the corresponding gender-based gaps.

Christina Koch was named by NASA as the first female astronaut assigned to a lunar mission after a 50-year hiatus.

Dong Hong Juan, from China, became the first female climber in the world to complete all 14 peaks above 8,000 meters when she scaled the summit of Mount Shishapangma in Tibet in April.

Kirsten Neuschäfer became the first woman to win the Golden Globe Race, a sailing race around the world. She finished in 233 days, 20 hours, 43 minutes and 47 seconds.

Ritu Karidhal Srivastava, affectionately known as the 'Rocket Woman of India' successfully headed the team of 54 female scientists and engineers who played a pivotal part in scripting history through the landing of Chandrayaan-3 on the south pole of the lunar surface.

To celebrate the resounding success of women across all fields and to keep the spirit ignited, Center for Human Rights & Gender Studies & SDG Club in collaboration with the Conference and seminar Committee, School of Law Galgotias University proposes to celebrate International Women's Day on 7th March 2024 through National Seminar 2024.

The theme for International Women's Day 2024 is "Invest In Women: Accelerate Progress". Taking cue from this, the theme for National Seminar 2024 "

Invest in Women: Accelerating Progress in Developing Societies". This one-day national seminar would feature resource persons, working for the development of women and plugging gender gaps, deliberating upon critical issues related to women and gender studies from a multi-disciplinary angle and approaches.

The national seminar is focused on sustainable development goal (SDG) 5: Gender Equality. The 17 SDGs recognize that action in one area will affect outcomes in others, and that development must balance social, economic and environmental sustainability. SDG 5 has nine targets and 14 indicators. Six of the targets are outcome targets:

- Ending all forms of discrimination against all women and girls everywhere
- Ending violence and exploitation of women and girls
- Eliminating harmful practices such as child early and forced marriage and female genital mutilation
- Increasing value of unpaid care and promoting shared domestic responsibilities
- Ensuring full participation of women in leadership and decision-making
- Ensuring access to universal reproductive rights and health

At National Seminar 2024, we invite researchers, academicians, professionals, and industry experts to contribute and share their knowledge, experience, and research outcomes. This seminar would provide a platform for exchanging ideas, discussing challenges, and exploring solutions to address the pressing issues related to gender equality and sustainable growth of women in all spectrum of society.
