- Title of the Paper
- Name of the author(s)
- E-mail address
- Postal address and Contact Number
- Co-authorship is allowed. (*Max. two authors.*)

➤ **Important Instructions For Full Length Paper Submission:**

- **Word Limit** – 4000 to 8000 [*Excluding footnotes and Abstract*].
- **Citation Format** – Bluebook (21st edition).
- **Font** – Times New Roman (12), Line-Spacing: 1.5, Headings (14).

- **Last date for Abstract Submission:** 4th April, 2024, 11:59 PM
- **Last Date of Intimation of Selected Abstracts:** April 6, 2024, 11:59 PM.
- **Last Date for Registration:** 8th April, 2024, 11:59 PM.

- **Last Date for Final Paper Submission:** 8th May 2024, 11:59 PM.
