SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. The sub-themes mentioned are broad indicative themes only. The Chapter will also be considered if connected with the theme of the book.
2. The abstract must not exceed 250-300 words and shall contain 4-5 keywords.
3. The word limit for the chapter is up to 4000-6000 words (including footnotes).
4. Format of manuscripts: Font: Times New Roman, (with font size 12, line spacing of 1.5, and a Title in font size 14).
5. The manuscript should contain footnotes. There should be no endnotes.
6. The ILI citation style must be followed.
7. The tables and figures should be placed within the text, not at the end. The table and figures must be numbered as Table 1, Figure 1, etc.
8. Every contributor must attach a copy of the Plagiarism Report (turnitin) at the time of full chapter submission. A chapter having more than a 15% similarity index shall not be accepted and shall be liable to be rejected.
9. Only ORIGINAL submissions will be accepted for publication. Manuscripts must not have been previously published or be submitted for publication elsewhere.
10. All manuscripts will be accepted based on a blind peer-review editorial process.
11. The book is scheduled to be published by Allahabad Law Agency with an ISBN.
12. The chapter must be sent only through mail provided and include a cover letter containing the author's/authors' name/s, Institutional designation (if applicable), email address, and contact number.
13. Co-authorship is allowed only upto two.
14. A confirmation email for acceptance of the abstract shall be sent after the review.
15. After the acceptance of the abstract, the author is required to submit the full chapter by the due date and the acceptance of the chapter shall be sent separately via Gmail.

3.) Citation style to be followed: ILI (Indian Law Institute)

4.) The payment is to be made only after the paper is accepted. The payment link will be provided in the mail itself.
