About the Workshop

Criminal law defines offences, regulates the apprehension, charging, and trial of suspected individuals, and establishes penalties and modes of treatment for convicted offenders. It is a vital mechanism through which organized societies safeguard individual interests and ensure the survival of the community. While family, school, religion, and civil life also instill standards of conduct, criminal law specifically addresses offenses against the public. Unlike tort law (which deals with private injuries), criminal law focuses on offences that impact society as a whole. Historically, criminal sanctions aimed at retribution and expiation of moral guilt, but modern perspectives emphasize crime prevention and protection of the public.

On December 21, 2023, the Parliament of India passed three significant legislations, replacing the existing colonial-era laws. The new criminal laws are Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023.

Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 (BNS) is a comprehensive effort which redefines and refocuses the penal code. It introduces a nuanced approach to offences, penalizing actions that endanger India's sovereignty, unity, and integrity. The BNS addresses contemporary challenges such as terrorism and organized crime, distinguishing between heinous and petty offences and prescribing stringent penalties for the heinous offences.

Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) is aimed at humanizing the criminal justice system. This law sets timelines for investigations, making justice more accessible and responsive. It replaces outdated terminology with a more people-friendly language. Notably, in cases involving heinous offenses, the legislation emphasizes mandatory forensic team visits to enhance the thoroughness and accuracy of criminal investigations.

Recognizing the growing role of technology in legal proceedings, Bhartiya Sakshya Adhiniyam 2023 (BSA) acknowledges electronic evidence as any information generated or transmitted by devices or systems capable of storing or retrieving data. It covers a wide range of digital data, from emails to multimedia files, ensuring the credibility of electronic evidence presented in court. Special provisions for DNA evidence and expert opinions further strengthen the act's commitment to a modern and effective legal framework.

These reforms mark a significant shift in India's justice delivery system, aiming to create legislation that is more responsive, equitable, and better suited to meet society's evolving needs. The new laws are set to come into effect from July 1, 2024.

Keeping in view these changes in criminal laws, One - Day National workshop is being organized by School of Law, Bennett University. The primary objective of the event to raise awareness among the participants and provide a comprehensive understanding of the recent criminal law reforms in India i.e., Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023. Participants will gain insights into the key changes, implications, and practical aspects of implementing these new laws.
