- a 1,500-word outline of their presentation by 31st December 2024;
- a 5-to-8,000-word article based on their presentation by 31st May 2025. The ESG chairpersons will
 work with the presenters to find a suitable venue to publish these papers, including the
 ILAThinkFactory.
