## **Submission**

#### Guidelines

Please submit your abstract within 250 words and with 5 to 6 keywords. Full paper (within 4000-6000) words, including images, graphs, result tables and references) to be submitted once abstract acceptance status is updated to you via email. Your article should follow the mentioned guidelines:

- 1. Title page comprising the following- Abstract Title, Sub-theme Title, Author's & Co-author's Names, Designation & Institutional Affiliation, Correspondence Details
- 2. Files should be either in PDF or Microsoft Word format
- 3. Use Times New Roman, 12-Font, 1.5 line spacing, with 'Justify' alignment
- 4. Only Titles, Sub-titles and Headings to be in Bold
- 5. Adhere to the APA style guide for referencing
- 6. Incomplete paper, and plagiarized work will not be considered for final review



#### Instructions for the

#### **Authors**

- 1. Papers must be submitted online using the Editorial Manager (EM) EASYCHAIR system,
- which is a completely web-based submission, peer-review, and tracking system.
- 2. All submissions must be in English and include a brief abstract. It will be evaluated by independent experts (at least three) in the Blind peer review process.
- 3. All pages must be numbered in the same order. Tables and ¬gures can be included within the text or placed on other pages with appropriate captions (s).
- 4. The title of the paper, the author's name(s), and entire institutional aliation(s) should all be mentioned on the ¬rst page of the manuscript. There should also be an abbreviated title (for running heads).
- 5. A list of 4—6 keywords should be provided immediately after the abstract. These keywords should be relatively independent (coordinate index terms) and should best describe the paper as a whole.
- 6. Footnotes, if any, should be numbered alphabetically and inserted at the end of a text page,
- apart from acknowledgements and grant information (not to be listed separately).
- 7. All the references should be mentioned in alphabetical order.
- 8. Submissions that do not follow the above instructions may be returned to the authors for correction before being published.





- 1. Parallel submissions of the same Research Paper to a di\_x001D\_erent Conference, Journals or Symposium will not be accepted.
- 2. Papers having content outside the scope will not be reviewed.
- 3. In accordance with the review policy, submissions will be assessed by 3 experts as suggested by the organizing committee.
- 4. Presentation and publication-related decision(s) are made by the Organizing Committee based on the reports given by the experts. The authors of papers that are not approved will be notic¬ed promptly and the decision taken by the organizing committee will be the nal verdict.
- 5. All the submitted papers are considered con-fidential documents. We expect our Board of Reviewing Editors and reviewers to treat the papers as confi-dential matters as well.
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- 7. Editors and reviewers engaged in the review procedure must state any con ict of interest arising from direct competition, collaboration or other ties with any of the authors, and should withdraw themselves from situations where such con icts prevent objective evaluation. The utilization of privileged information or ideas received via peer review for competitive benefit is prohibited.
- 8. Review reports should be made available on request to the Managing Editor if required
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# Ethical Policy

Authors must be truthful when reporting their study ¬ndings and conclusions. Knowledge is damaged by research malpractice. It has the potential to mislead other researchers.

#### **a** Research Results:

Security breaches or research results from others, as well as data manipulation, misre presentation, or biased reporting with the purpose to mislead or deceive, is unethical. The ndings of research should be documented and required to le so that they can be analysed and reviewed. The information should be stored for a reasonable time after publication and made available upon request. Exceptions may be appropriate in some cases to safeguard privacy, ensure patent protection, or for other similar reasons.

### **b** Authorship:

Everyone who has made a major contribution must be given the opportunity to be recognized as an author/ co-author. Other people who have helped with the project should also be recognized. All authors, both academic and corporate, should report a complete disclosure of their current institutional aliations in their articles.



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Human and Animal Rights:

If there is the usage of human subjects or human medical data in the work, the author should ensure the work described is executed in accordance with the Research Ethics Committee's approval.
