

The Delhi Campus of NESU, formerly Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology & Forensic Science (LNJN NICFS), was established by the Government of India, under the Ministry of Home Affairs, in the year 1972 to promote Criminology and Forensic Science through education, research and training. During its 46 years of existence, the Institute has made significant headway in the training of officials of the criminal justice system and forensic scientists, and in conducting research in applied aspects of the two subjects. LNJN NICFS regularly organizes seminars, orientations and

specialized courses which include attendees from Police, Civil Administration, Prosecution, Judiciary, Correctional Administration, Customs, Vigilance Departments of PSUs, Services and Forensic Defence Laboratories from different states of India. In addition to that, these courses have also been attended by officers from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Fiji, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Malaysia, Maldives, Sudan, Myanmar, Nepal, Palestine, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Uganda and Zambia.

The Department of Forensic Science at NFSU's Delhi Campus aims to develop skilled professionals for criminal investigations through top-tier teaching, research, training, and innovations. As crime types and methods evolve, the need for qualified forensic experts is crucial. The department offers specialized interdisciplinary postgraduate courses, providing an excellent forensic education and research environment. With a unique curriculum, state-of-the-art infrastructure, and a diverse faculty, it fosters an intellectually and culturally enriching academic setting. The department promotes forensic sciences by setting new educational, research, and training benchmarks, aiding the criminal justice system with problem-solving approaches and offering training to officers and forensic scientists. It also supports international cooperation and crime control through academic activities and collaborations.



ABOUT FDP:

Forensic science has evolved significantly in recent decades, with advancements in scientific investigative tools enhancing the efficiency, specificity, sensitivity, and speed of tests. The introduction of Point of Care (PoC) tests has expanded the scope of forensic investigations. However, the practical application of advanced techniques remains limited, requiring thorough discussion and proper training for practitioners. The forensic science community has faced challenges from the apex court regarding the reliability of forensic reports, highlighting the need for robust and accurate forensic practices.

To address these issues, the Department of Forensic Science at NFSU's Delhi Campus proposes a 5-day international Faculty Development Program (FDP). This program aims to raise awareness among forensic science stakeholders about modern forensic tools and techniques. It will cover various branches of forensic science, such as Forensic Chemistry, Toxicology, Physics, Ballistics, Biotechnology, Cyber Forensics, and more. Sessions will also focus on the admissibility, error rates, and authenticity of modern techniques in court.

The program will feature national and international experts sharing their insights, making it accessible and beneficial for both forensic and non-forensic participants, including faculty, research scholars, and legal practitioners.


