 - a. Research papers: Between 5000 and 10000 words, including footnotes.
 - b. Expert's Comments: Between 2000 and 3000 words, including footnotes.
 - c. Judgment Analysis/ Comments: Between 2000 and 4000 words, including footnotes.
 - d. Book/Reports Review: Between 2000 and 3000 words, including footnotes.
- The topic must be in nexus with the domain of this special issue.

- All Articles must be accompanied by an abstract of about 250- 300 words stating the theme of the paper precisely, along with keywords.
