The Final Submission should include the following sections in the specified order:

- Title of the Chapter
- Name of the Author and Co-author (if any)
- Designation and Affiliation
- Contact details (email addresses and phone numbers)
- Abstract
- Keywords
- Main Text
- References

♦ LENGTH AND STRUCTURE

- The chapter should be in the range between 5000-7,500 words but not exceeding the upper limit, including footnotes and references.
- Ensure the chapter is well-structured with appropriate headings and subheadings to enhance readability.

LANGUAGE AND STYLE

- All submissions must be in English.
- Use clear and concise language, adhering to academic writing standards. Also ensure proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation.

FORMATTING

- Use Times New Roman font, size 12, justified text alignment, and 1.5 line spacing.
- Paper size should be A4 with 1 cm margins on all sides.

REFERENCES AND CITATIONS

- Use a consistent citation style (preferably APA or ILI).
- Include a comprehensive reference list at the end of the chapter.
- Ensure all in-text citations are properly formatted and correspond to the reference list.

ORIGINALITY AND PLAGIARISM

- Submissions must be the original work of the author(s). It will be checked for plagiarism,
 and any work found to be plagiarized more than 10 percent will be disqualified.
- Properly cite all sources and references.

REVIEW AND EDITING

• Authors are encouraged to thoroughly review and edit their work before submission.
