GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

- Full papers should be submitted in MS Word format.
- Formatting requirements:
 - o Font: Times New Roman
 - o Title: Font size 14
 - o Subtitles: Font size 13
 - o Body text: Font size 12
 - o Line spacing: 1.5 lines
 - o The paper should not exceed 6,000 words, including footnotes. Papers exceeding this word limit may be rejected.
- Submission of a paper implies the author's consent to its publication and the transfer of copyright to Nims University (Nims School of Law). The author also consents to editorial modifications, and will cooperate with the editors for any required revisions.
- References should be cited as footnotes, formatted according to the BLUE BOOK 19[™] EDITION, with a font size of 10.
- The work must be original, unpublished, and not under submission elsewhere.

PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITY

All submitted papers will undergo blind peer review and plagiarism check. Selected papers will be considered for publication in an **Edited Book with ISBN**.

RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- Peer Review Process: All submitted abstracts will undergo peer review by the Organizing Committee. Only the shortlisted abstracts will be invited for final paper submission. Participants must ensure that final papers are submitted within the designated deadlines following the acceptance of their abstract.
- Submission Deadlines: No abstracts or final papers will be accepted beyond the respective submission deadlines. Timely submissions are crucial to ensure participation.






