## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. The teams shall comprise 2 participants. One to speak for the motion and the other against.
- 2. The participant speaking for the motion will speak first, the speaking time for both the speakers will be 4 Minutes and additional 2 minutes for rebuttal.
- 3. A warning bell shall be rung 1 minute prior to the set time limit, content spoken post the given time limit will not be marked by the judges.
- 4. Cross-talks will be highly discouraged, making personal remarks or comments on other teams or individuals could lead to direct dismissal from the event.
- 5. An individual cannot ask questions to their own teammate.
- 6. The contestants will be marked on the basis of their content, articulation, oratory skills, rebuttals, behavior and presence of mind.
- 7. Any team that violates any work-place rules shall be held accountable for their actions and therefore be disqualified from the competition with immediate effect.
- 8. An institution can send more than 1 team. All teams will have to register individually.

## 9. Structure of the Competition

- There will be Preliminary, Quarterfinal, Semi-Final and Final Rounds.
- In preliminary rounds, Both the members of the team will be speaking on the topic (One for the Motion and One against the motion). Top 8 Teams will qualify for Quarter Final Rounds.
- In the Quarterfinals the speakers of the teams shall switch sides and speak from the opposite perspective.
- In the Semi-Finals, a new impromptu topic shall be given to the teams with 20 minutes of preparation time. (One team member will speak for the motion and the other against the motion)
- In the final round, there will be a draw of chits that will decide the sides for both the teams. In this round, the speakers of the team shall collectively speak from one side in a direct face off round with the other finalist team.
- 10. The dress code for the event is Western or traditional formals.
