About the Programme The progress of any nation is dependent on the expanse and quality of its education system. Teachers are the soul of a nation's education system. It is the quality of teachers which determines the quality of education which in turn determines the path a nation takes. Here, the role of Higher Education becomes even more pronounced as Higher Education develops the knowledge, research and human capital of the country. For India, a country that is aiming to leaping into the next stage of its growth trajectory, the role of higher education lies the key to achieve its vision. It can be easily understood that development of faculty is of the highest necessity to achieve quality and excellence in Higher Education. At present, there is a predisposition in Higher Education to focus only on the domain (subject) knowledge, which further permeates in students. By extension, a lack of focus on andragogy, methodology, approaches and research dulls the quality of the teacher, thereby reducing the effectiveness and impact of education for generations of students. As such, for the development of Higher Education, it was felt pertinent to increase the quality of learning experience in the different educational programmes for which continuous investment in Faculty Development is vital.

Faculty Development has a critical role to play in promoting academic excellence and innovation. It is especially essential that such development takes in the early stages of teaching career of a faculty. Inculcating the needed value systems, and incorporating the necessary knowledge-sets, mind-sets and skill-sets in the teaching career of a faculty member especially in early stages is not only beneficial to the faculty but to the student and society at large. The exposure to Induction Programmes will therefore improve faculty quality and effectiveness, while simultaneously and significantly expand the horizons of teaching for faculty members. The development of Faculty Members is one of the priority actions in Higher Education aimed at improving the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

It is with this view that the **Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre, Shri Ram College of Commerce (MMTTC, SRCC)** is organizing the **1st Short Term Programme (STP)** from **October 21, 2024 to October 26, 2024** in **Online** Mode under the **Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP)** of the **Ministry of Education, Government of India**. The Online STP will focus extensively on research methodologies, art of writing, citation management, publication process and research ethics etc. In doing so, the aim of the STP will ensure three possible types of development personal (*research skills and orientation*), organizational (*ways to improve the institutional environment to better support research*) and professional (*ways to support faculty members so that they fulfil their multiple roles of teaching, research, and service*).



Objectives of the Programme The prime objective of the **1st Short Term Programme (STP) on Research Methodology** is to sensitize and motivate faculty to adopt research orientation and enhance the quality and impact of research within the institution. *Additional objectives of the Online STP include:*

1. To promote personal, organisational and professional development of faculty members.
2. To educate faculty on how to publish their research findings in academic journals and present at conferences, including best practices for academic writing.
3. To promote academic excellence, teaching innovation, research capabilities and leadership skills.
4. To improve the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality research.

Modules Covered under the Programme *The following Modules will be covered in the Online STP :*

Module 1: Introduction to Research; Identification of the Research Gaps; Framing Research Objectives

Module 2: Literature Review; Ethics in Research; Plagiarism

Module 3: Publication Process; Citation Management

Module 4: Art of writing Research Papers

Module 5: Research Design; Network Theory

Module 6: Harnessing AI for research ; IPR and Patents

Mode and Delivery of the Programme The Programme will be held in **Live Online Mode**.

The duration of **Online STP** is **36 hours** conducted over

a period of **Six (6 days) October 21, 2024 to October 26, 2024**. Each day, there will be **four live** online sessions of **ninety (90) minutes** each, thereby totalling to **six (6) hours** of learning per day. 2

Who can

apply for the STP

The **Short Term Programme (STP)** is designed for Faculty members in Central, State, Deemed to be Universities, Private Universities, Institutions of National Importance, Colleges and other HEIs, that are included under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act. The teachers of colleges that do not yet come within the purview of Section 2(f), but have been affiliated to a university for at least three years, will be permitted to participate in the courses.

Please note that Faculty Members desirous of registering for the Online STP must have an **No Objection Certificate** from their Institution on its Official Letterhead.

Requisites

for completion of the STP

- 1. Attendance is compulsory for all Sessions.**
- 2. Assessment will be as per MMTTC Guidelines: Two tests of MCQs (30 marks each) + Assignments (20 marks) + Overall response (20 marks). Timely Assessment Submission is mandatory.**
- 3. Submission of Session-Wise Feedback is necessary.**
- 4. Passing of Assessment is mandatory.**

An Online Certificate of Completion will be issued only to those who have **100% attendance** for the Programme and qualified the assessment parameters.



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Intended Outcomes for the Programme ❖ Equip Faculty Members with foundation in principles and practices of research methodology, including qualitative and quantitative approaches.

- ❖ Develop personal, organisational and professional competencies.
- ❖ Learn how to formulate research questions, develop hypotheses, and design effective research studies.

- ❖ Introduce faculty to emerging technologies and tools that can enhance research processes and methodologies.

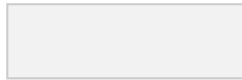
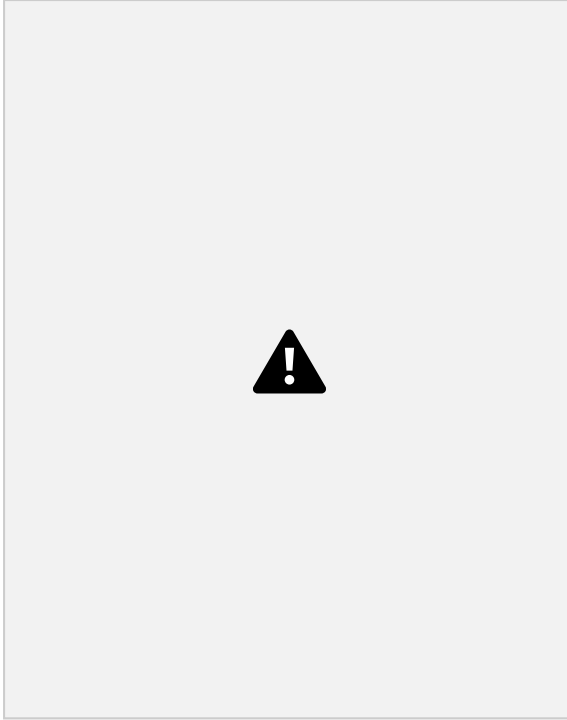
