- > Short Articles: 3000 to 6000 words
- > Case Comments and Notes: 1,800 to 3,000 words
- > Book Reviews: 1,500 to 2,500 words
- Note: Word limits are exclusive of footnotes.

Any issues of contemporary nature based on Constitutional law, Family law, Property law, Criminal law, Al and Law, Business Laws, ADR, Intellectual Property Rights, Cyber Law, Sports Law, etc.

#### **Submission Guidelines**

- > Submissions must be in electronic form sent via email to LawReview@woxsen.edu.in
- ➤ The submission shall not contain the name of the author or institutional affiliation or any other identification mark (except in the cover letter).
- > Submission shall be sent in Word format only.
- ➤ A separate cover letter in Word format containing the following particulars of the author(s) is to be sent along with the submission:
- > Title of Submission
- > Name of the Author and Co-Author(s)
- Designation
- > Institutional Affiliation
- > Contact Information and Address for Correspondence
- > Co-authorship: Co-authorship of up to two authors is permitted

#### **Formatting Guidelines**

- > The font must be Times New Roman and sized 12 for the main text, and 10 for the footnotes.
- > Line Spacing must be 1.5 for the main text and 1.0 for the footnotes.
- > Each submission apart from the book review should be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 200 words and five keywords

## **Citation Style**

Citation style must adhere to OSCOLA (4th edition).

## **Publication Policy**

The Submissions must be original. Plagiarism up to 10% is permissible. The author(s) are expected to submit a declaration of originality with their submission. Submission of work demonstrates that the authors confer exclusive permission to WLR in order to publish and reproduce their work in all streams of media. In addition to this, the editors are entitled to reserve to delete or edit any article, research paper, case comment or book review whose content is found to be offensive, defamatory, unethical, or if it is suggestive of gender or religious discrimination, illegal or terror activities etc. Moreover, the double-blind peer review process will be exercised to scrutinize all the submissions
