

CALL FOR PAPERS CONSTITUTION MAKING INTEREST GROUP

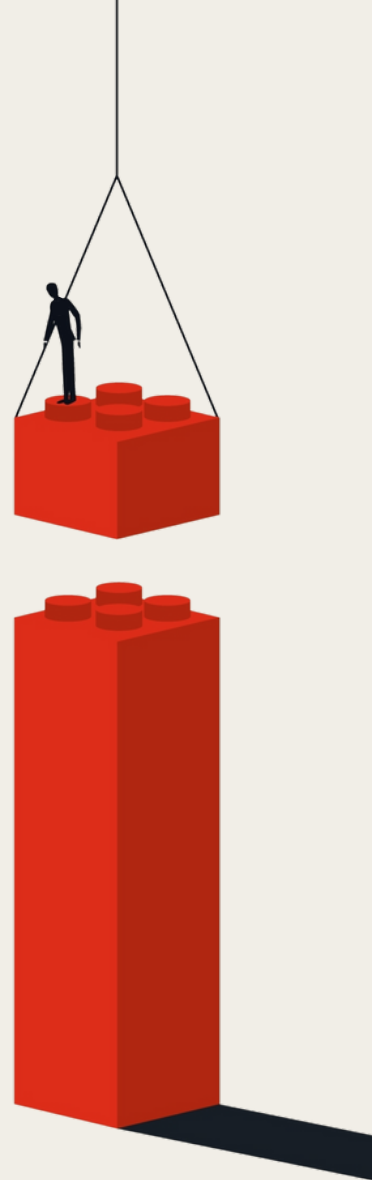
ICON•S ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2025

The ICON•S Constitution Making Interest Group is looking to assemble comprehensive panels focusing on in-progress research papers related to constitution-making at the upcoming ICON•S Annual Conference, scheduled to take place in Brasilia from July 28 to 30, 2025.

The aim is to showcase emerging research and foster robust dialogue in the field of constitution-making. The papers can relate to any and all aspects of constitution-making, be theoretical, conceptual, normative or empirical in nature, and focus on one or more jurisdictions.

Ideally, each panel will comprise two to three research papers, with each paper being discussed by a designated discussant. Additionally, a chair will oversee the panel to ensure a focused discussion. This format is designed to foster in-depth analysis and constructive feedback.

We welcome scholars, practitioners, and graduate students to submit paper proposals and to volunteer as discussants.



How to Submit A Paper Proposal or Volunteer As A Discussant

At this stage, please provide your paper title and a concise description (approximately 150-250 words).
