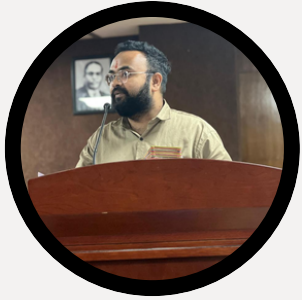

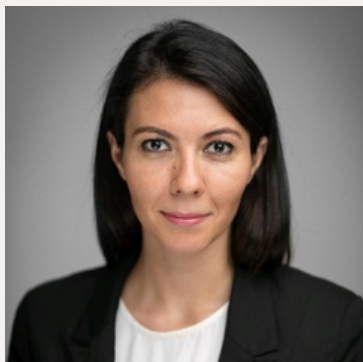

# ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The Asian Forum for International Academic Interaction (AFIAI) in association with UTTARA UNIVERSITY, Bangladesh is organizing a five-day online seminar titled "Contemporary Challenges and Innovations in Alternative Dispute Resolution: Bridging Theory and Practice," aimed at fostering dialogue and collaboration among academics, legal professionals, students, and corporate stakeholders. As Asia emerges as a pivotal region for ADR development, with its diverse legal traditions and economic priorities, the seminar will explore both conventional and innovative ADR methods, from mediation and arbitration to cutting-edge digital solutions. By addressing interdisciplinary perspectives, such as the ethical implications of AI and community conflict management, the seminar seeks to deepen participants' understanding of ADR's evolving role while equipping them with practical skills through workshops and sessions on negotiation and complex arbitration. Additionally, the event aims to inspire new research, promote collaborative networking, and prepare participants to address modern ADR challenges, bridging the gap between theory and practice in personal, corporate, and international disputes.



# THEMATIC AREAS FOR THE SUBMISSION

**1. Technological Advancements in ADR** - This includes digital ADR platforms, artificial intelligence, blockchain technology, cybersecurity, ethics, and more aspects of technology driven dispute resolution.

**2. ADR in Specific Legal and Social Contexts** - This includes workplace disputes, family law, sports arbitration, consumer protection, public-private partnerships, and more aspects related to resolving disputes in specific areas.

**3. Global and Cultural Dimensions of ADR** - This includes environmental disputes, cultural adaptability, human rights, international trade and investment, global ADR governance, and more aspects of cross-border and culturally sensitive ADR.

**4. Ethics, Confidentiality, and Financial Dynamics in ADR** - This includes transparency vs. confidentiality, third-party funding, professional ethics, conflicts of interest, cross-border confidentiality, and more aspects of ethical and financial challenges in ADR.

**5. Evolving Frameworks and Professional Development in ADR** - This includes the evolution of ADR practices, ISDS reforms, future skills, emerging sectors, standardization efforts, and more aspects of adapting ADR to contemporary and future challenges.

Note: Sub-themes are not exhaustive, but indicative of the broader technical sessions for paper presentation and expert address.

## PROCEDURE FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Participants are invited to submit an abstract (250-350 words) as an attachment in a Word file. All abstracts will undergo a double blind peer review process before acceptance.

Along with the abstract, the following information must be provided in the given format:

- Address and Email ID
- Title of Abstract
- Mobile No.



# GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

Full papers should be submitted in MS Word format.

- Formatting requirements:

- o Font: Times New Roman

- o Title: Font size 14

- o Subtitles: Font size 13

- o Body text: Font size 12

- o Line spacing: 1.5 lines

- o The paper should not exceed 5,000 words, including footnotes. Papers exceeding this word limit may be rejected.

- Submission of a paper implies the author's consent to its publication and the transfer of copyright to AFIAI . The author also consents to editorial modifications, and will cooperate with the editors for any required revisions.

- References should be cited as footnotes, formatted according to the BLUE BOOK 21 EDITION, with a font size of 10.

- The work must be original, unpublished, and not under submission elsewhere.

## PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITY

All submitted papers will undergo blind peer review and plagiarism check. Selected papers will be considered for reputed publication with an ISBN/Selected papers will be considered for publication with an open access doi, for maximum visibility and citation for the work.

## RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Peer Review Process: All submitted abstracts will undergo double blind peer review by the Organizing Committee. Only the shortlisted abstracts will be invited for final paper submission.

Participants must ensure that final papers are submitted within the designated deadlines following the acceptance of their abstract. Submission Deadlines: No abstracts or final papers will be accepted beyond the respective submission deadlines.

Timely submissions are crucial to ensure participation.

A maximum of 2 authorship would be allowed with a separate registration of both the authors.

Registration Requirement: All participants, including paper presenters, must register during the abstract submission phase by paying the required fees. Participation in the conference is strictly limited to registered individuals.

Certification: Registered participants will receive e-certificates, with distinct certificates provided for paper presenters

**NOTE- Certificates for non-submission or non-presentation, presentation without a full paper, and late submissions will only be allowed with prior approval of the organizing committee.**
