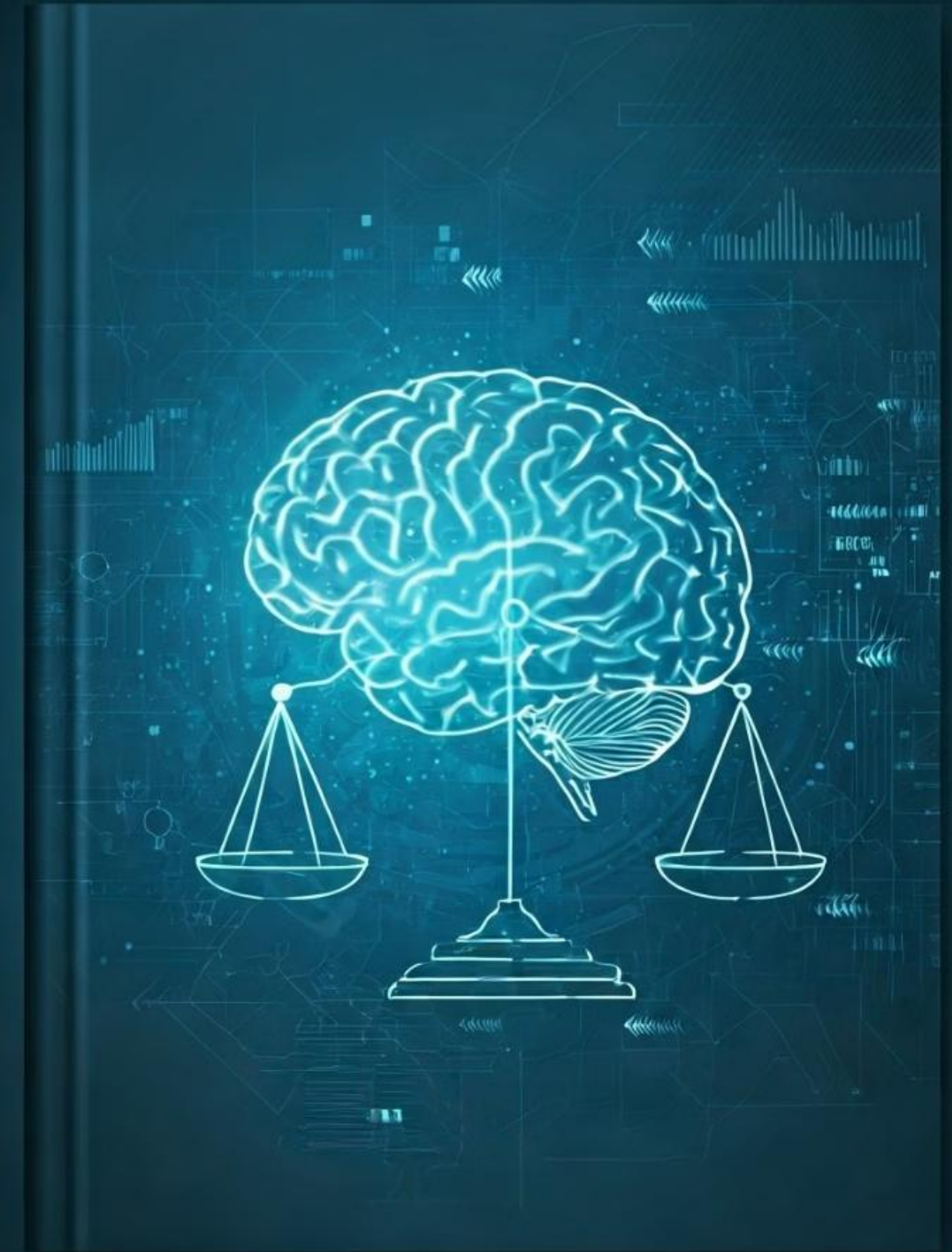


Call for Chapters for Book on Artificial Intelligence and Law in India

Chapters are invited from Academicians, Professionals, Advocates, Practitioners, Research Scholars and Students on Artificial Intelligence and Law in India.

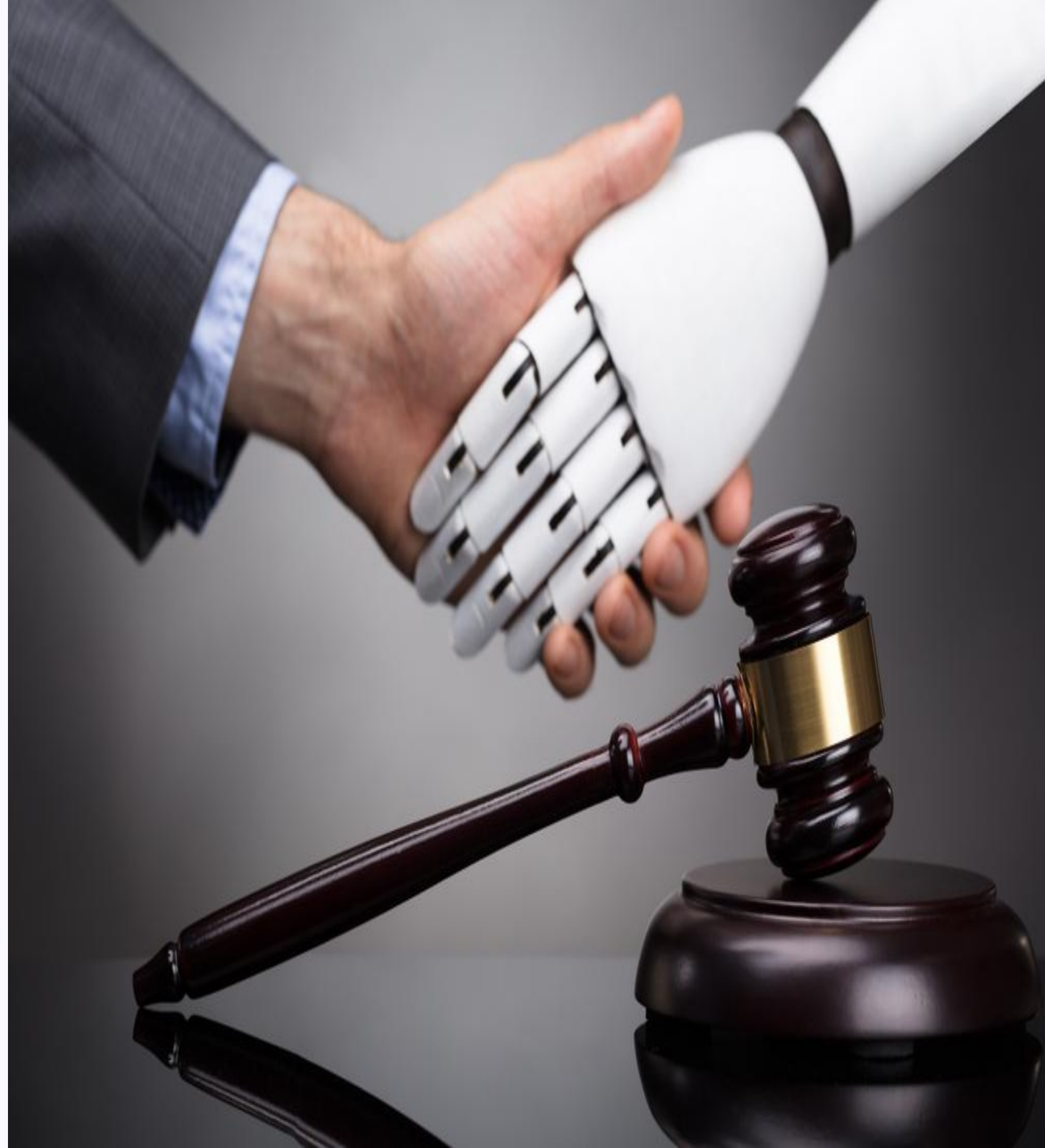

Abstract

The abstract should be between 250-350 word

Articles

Submissions are accepted in the form of Articles between 3000-5000 words.

Word Limit

Word limit is including abstracts, citations and footnoting.

Formatting

All submissions must be in Times New Roman, Main Content- font size 14, Heading- font size 16, Footnoting 11, spacing 1.5, Margins: Left 1 Inch, Right 1 Inch, Top 1 Inch, and Bottom 1 Inch.

Footnoting and Citations

Footnoting and Citations must strictly conform to the standards laid down by ILI.

Responsibility

The submitted work must adhere to the general rules, and the author(s) are solely responsible for the correctness of any facts, opinions or viewpoints expressed in it. The language employed must not be derogatory or result in disrepute of any individual.

Plagiarism

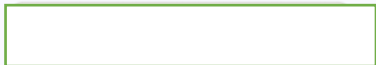

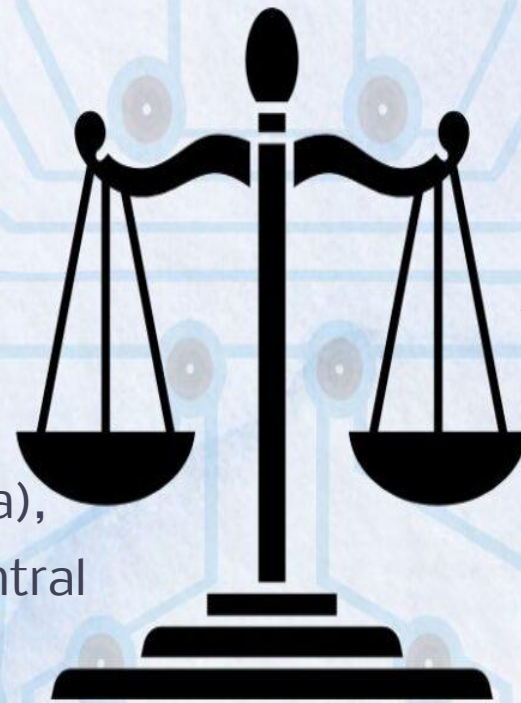
