
ABOUT M.C.E. SOCIETY, PUNE

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION

Each presenter will have 10 minutes (including Q&A). Focus on presenting objectives, methods, results, and conclusions clearly. Use PowerPoint or similar software with visuals (charts, graphs, images) for better impact. Submit your slides to the organizing team before the conference. Stick to the time limit to ensure a smooth session flow. Equipment (projector, microphone, laptop) will be provided. Arrive 10 minutes early to your session hall for setup.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters should summarize the research (title, objectives, methods, results, and conclusions). The standard poster size is 2x3 feet (24 inches width x 36 inches height). Include the title, author names, affiliations, and contact details prominently. Use clear, readable text with visuals (charts, images, graphics) for better impact. Submit your poster in PDF format to the organizing team for review before printing. Approved posters will be displayed on 2x3 feet boards at the venue. Presenters must stand by their posters to explain and answer questions. Materials will be provided, arrive 15 minutes early to set up posters.

PUBLICATION DETAILS

Selected research papers will be published in UGC CARE-listed journals. Papers not selected for journals will be published in a conference book with ISBN (978-93-95732-25-3) / peer Review journal. A publication charge of Rs. 600/- (in addition to the registration fee) applies for the ISBN book

REVIEW PROCESS

All submissions will undergo a double-blind review to ensure unbiased evaluation. Expert reviewers will assess abstracts and full papers for originality, clarity, adherence to conference themes, and academic integrity, including proper citations and plagiarism checks. Based on detailed recommendations, the conference committee will decide on acceptance for presentation. Constructive feedback will be provided to authors, whether their work is accepted or not. Only submissions meeting high academic standards and conference objectives will be selected. The reviewers' decisions are final, ensuring a fair and rigorous process.
