

OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

- Enhance participants to acquire investigative skills and practical knowledge of forensic science.
- Provide hands-on experience in crime scene analysis.
- Encourage teamwork and analytical thinking among law students and forensic enthusiasts.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

- Assesses students' ability to perform crime scene investigation procedures and hypothesize suspects.
- Enhances understanding of crime investigation through the examination of physical evidence.
- Develops reasoning and logical skills in analysing crime scenes.
- Incorporates multiple investigative techniques, including identifying, reporting, sketching, and photography.
- Focuses on suspect identification, reasoning, and observational skills.

NEED FOR CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION

• Systematic Evidence Collection

Helps gather and examine the evidence and to reconstruct crime sequences.

- Identifying Key Aspects Determines what transpired, identifies the responsible party, and understands the modus operandi.
- Solving and Prosecuting Crimes Proper recognition and collection of physical and digital evidence aid in addressing crimes.
- Role of Law Enforcement The effectiveness of prosecution depends on the evidence deduced by law enforcement officers through investigation.
- Legal Proficiency Investigative knowledge is essential for legal professionals handling criminal cases.
- **Broad Scope of Application** Fundamental knowledge of investigation is crucial for all professionals connected to the criminal justice system.







ELIGIBILITY

- Open to full-time UG and PG students across all discipline
- Teams must consist of two members.
- No restriction on the number of teams from an institution.

COMPETITION FORMAT & RULES

- Briefing & Orientation: Participants will receive a background overview and case facts before entering the crime scene.
- Crime Scene Observation:

Participants will have 10 minutes to observe and record findings.

Essential stationery (pen, pencil, eraser, notepad) will be provided. Additional materials must be brought by participants.

Use of Mobile phones is strictly not permitted.

Participants are not allowed to touch or move the evidence.

Report Preparation (30 Minutes):

Background of the crime.

Sketches (minimum of 2 and maximum of 5) of the crime scene.

List and classification of evidence with legal relevance.

Hypothesis regarding suspect(s) with reasoning.

Conclusive opinion-based story.


Forensic analysis and additional observations.

• Judging Criteria: Reports will be evaluated by forensic and legal experts based on accuracy, logical reasoning, and presentation.

KEY SKILL ASSESSED

- Observational & interpretational skills.
- Evidence handling and problem-solving abilities.
- Note-taking, sketching, and analytical thinking.
- Quality and clarity of report writing.
- Identifying the cause, suspect, and modus operandi of the crime.
