

- Submissions are to be made in the form of MS Word as well as Pdf Form in the provided google form.
- The essay must be an original, unpublished work of the participants.
- Word limit: 2500-5000 words, including citations
- Formatting: Times New Roman, Font Size 12, Line Spacing 1.5, Justified alignment.
- Headings and Sub-headings must be appropriately numbered.
- Referencing Style: The Bluebook- A Uniform System of Citation (2015, 20th ed.).
- Any submission that is found to be plagiarized beyond 15% shall be disqualified from the competition.
- Use of AI is strictly prohibited.
- Copyright of the submission shall remain with CCLG, DNLU.
