### EARLY-CAREER WORKSHOP ON PUBLIC POLICY 2025

As a response to the growing presence of young researchers in Italy working in the fields of public policy and public administration, the first edition of the **Early-Career Workshop On Public Policy (ECWOPP) 2025** aims to create a space for presenting ongoing projects, discussing theoretical and methodological challenges, and fostering collaboration among early-career scholars.

The event will have a full-day programme, including research presentation sessions (panel style) and two Q&A moments: one focused on career paths inside and outside academia, and another on publishing strategies in leading national and international journals. Internationally renowned scholars participating to the Q&A sessions include Giliberto Capano (UniBo), Tullia Galanti (UniMi), Stefania Profeti (UniBo), and Federico Toth (UniBo), among others.

The ECWOPP 2025 is supported by the Standing Group “Administrations and Public Policies” of the Italian Society of Political Science (Società Italiana Scienze Politica - SISP) and it will be hosted by the **Department of Political and Social Sciences (DPS)** of the University of Bologna on **June 4th, 2025**.
