








ABOUT NUJS




ABOUTIPILS


ABOUT THE DIALOGUE


PARTICIPATION

The Competition is open to students currently pursuing any undergraduate degree, postgraduate degree or a PhD program at any Indian University.












We will send an acknowledgement of registration mail within two (2) weeks of the completion of registration.













IN THE CASE OF DUAL-AUTHORSHIPS, THE SUBMISSION MUST BE MADE ONLY ONCE, AND THE CO-AUTHOR'S EMAIL ID MUST BE CC-ED IN THE EMAIL.

WORD LIMIT: THE MANUSCRIPTS MUST BE SUBMITTED AS ARTICLES WITH A MINIMUM OF 3500 WORDS. THERE IS NO MAXIMUM WORD LIMIT. THE WORD LIMIT IS INCLUSIVE OF FOOTNOTES.

<u>ABSTRACT</u>: SUBMISSIONS MUST NECESSARILY CONTAIN AN ABSTRACT OF NOT MORE THAN 200-300 WORDS. THE ABSTRACT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE INDICATED WORD LIMIT.

ORIGINALITY: ALL MANUSCRIPTS SUBMITTED MUST BE ORIGINAL AND UNPUBLISHED, AND MUST NOT BE UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR PUBLICATION AT ANY OTHER JOURNAL / BLOG.

PLAGIARISM & AI GUIDELINES: THE MANUSCRIPT MUST NOT BE SUBSTANTIALLY PLAGIARISED OR AI-GENERATED. VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN INSTANT DISQUALIFICATION, SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZERS.









- THE MANUSCRIPT TITLE SHOULD BE IN TIMES NEW ROMAN, BOLD, FONT SIZE 16, IN ALL CAPS, CENTER-ALIGNED, WITH 1.5 LINE SPACING.
- THE HEADINGS SHOULD BE IN TIMES NEW ROMAN, BOLD & ITALICISED, FONT SIZE 12, CENTER-ALIGNED WITH 1.5 LINE SPACING
- THE MAIN BODY SHOULD BE IN TIMES NEW ROMAN, FONT SIZE 12, WITH 1.5 LINE SPACING, 12 PTS PARAGRAPH SPACING, 1-INCH MARGINS ON ALL SIDES, AND JUSTIFIED ALIGNMENT.
- FOOTNOTES SHOULD BE IN TIMES NEW ROMAN, FONT SIZE 10, WITH 1.0 LINE SPACING AND JUSTIFIED ALIGNMENT.
