**Word-limit of the manuscript-** 3,500 to 5,000 words (including abstract and footnotes). Abstract shall be a minimum of 100 words and should not exceed 300 words.

**AI content and plagiarism-** Must not exceed 8% each

**Citation-** OSCOLA

**Number of authors-** Sole or Co-authorship (up to two authors) is permitted (**Note- One author can submit only one manuscript.**)

**Heading-** Times New Roman, Size 16, Bold, Aligned in Middle

**Sub-headings-** Times New Roman, Size 14, Bold, Justified

**Text-** Times New Roman, Size 12, Justified

**Footnotes-** Times New Roman, Size 10, Justified (Note- Endnotes are not allowed)
