Publication Fees

Publication Charge: There is no publication charge at any stage of your contribution. Those who want to receive a hard copy of the book must pay a minimum charge to the publisher to obtain it.

Guideline for the Contributors:

- All manuscripts must be accompanied by a covering letter with the name(s) of the author(s), official designation institution/affiliation, the title of the manuscript, and contact information (correspondence address, email, phone number)
- The manuscript must contain an Abstract of 250 Words with 5 Key Words.
- Contributions should be in English language only
- Electronic submissions should ideally be made in Word Format (doc)/(docx).
- Article should be written in Times New Roman with font size 12, 1.5 line Spacing.
- Text and citation style should strictly conform to the rules of the Indian Law Institute (ILI). This mode of citation must be strictly followed otherwise the paper shall not be considered for publication.
- Only One Co-Author will be allowed
- No biographical information or references, including the name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s) and acknowledgments should be included in the text of the manuscript, the name, or document properties. All such information may be incorporated in the cover letter accompanying the manuscripts
- The word limit for Articles/Research Papers is between 4000 to 6000 words (including footnotes and abstract). The word limit must be strictly adhered to.
- This book encourages original work of the contributors for publication and plagiarized work will not be considered for publication. Maximum 10% plagiarism is allowed and Authors requested to submit plagiarism report while submitting their manuscript.
- This book also promotes gender neutrality.
- The articles in the Journal shall be edited and published according to the orthographical and grammatical rules of Indian English, which is based on British English; thus, submissions in American English will be modified accordingly.
- Mere submission of a contribution shall not confer any claim for publication. The Editorial Board reserves all rights to take the decision to publish the contribution. The Board's decision as regards the interpretation of guidelines or any other matter related to the publication shall be final.
