► Full Paper:

1. The length of the full paper including tables, diagrams, illustrations, references, etc. shall not be less than 3000 words and shall not exceed 5000 words. (Excluding the footnotes).
2. Save your full paper file as: **FirstName_Paper**. Example: If the first author's name is Aarav, the file should be named **Aarav_Paper**.
3. The research paper shall be the original and unpublished work of the author. Co-authorship is permitted to a maximum of two authors. Each author is required to register and pay the registration fee individually.
4. The paper should be typed in Times New Roman 12-point font with 1.5 line spacing.
5. All footnotes must be in Font "Times New Roman", font size 10, with line spacing. All submissions must follow the "The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation (21st Edition).
6. The full paper should be submitted in soft copy (only after the acceptance of the abstract has been duly communicated) and shall be sent along with the screenshot of the registration fee on provided conference e-mail.
7. E-certificates will be provided to all the registered participants.
8. Selected Papers will be published in a book with ISBN Number.

The Best Paper Award will be presented during the Valedictory Session of the International Conference to recognize outstanding student contributions.
