Submission Guidelines:

- Abstract length: 350 - 400 words clearly mentioning objectives, methodology, key findings/arguments and 3 to 5 keywords.
- Full papers should be between 3,000–5,000 words, formatted in APA style.
- Include: Title, Author(s), Designation, Affiliation, and Contact Details
- Submissions can be sent to:

• **Publication:**

Selected papers will be published in the special issue of Xavier's peer reviewed ISSN journal Xplore (ISSN: 2249- 1878). Authors will have to submit a declaration form upon selection of their paper.

Papers are invited under the subthemes mentioned above. Papers should be typewritten in Times New Roman font (in MS word), with double line spacing (not less than 6 mm) on A4 size paper leaving a good margin (25 mm on all sides). Tables and Captions to figures should be typed on separate pages. Tables should be sent in a form ready for publication and their position should be indicated in the text. Large tables with raw data should be avoided. The typescript should be carefully checked for spelling and words to be set in italics should be underlined. Footnotes are not allowed. Submissions will be accepted with a similarity index of up to 10%, provided that proper citations and references are included. Authors are encouraged to submit manuscripts electronically. Electronic submission should be sent as e-mail attachments in the following formats: Text in MSWord; Figures in Autocad, Corel draw, WMF, TIFF, BMP and Photographs in JPG, PSDF and should not exceed 15 MB including figures and tables, when sent through email.
