ABOUT TNDALU

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University was established by the Government of Tamil Nadu under Act No. 43 of 1997 to promote learning, teaching, and research in law. It was inaugurated by His Excellency Shri K.R. Narayanan, former President of India, on September 20, 1997, and commenced functioning on October 3, 1997. Recognised by the Bar Council of India and the University Grants Commission (Sec. 2f & 12b), the University is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities, the Association of Commonwealth Universities (U.K.), and the Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi. As the first sui generis law university in India, it serves as a nodal agency for advancing legal education in Tamil Nadu. The University offers programmes through its campus and twenty-seven affiliated colleges. The School of Excellence in Law, established in 2002, offers three-year and five-year integrated law courses. The Postgraduate and Research Centres provide LL.M., Ph.D., and LL.D. programmes in diverse legal specialisations.



DEPARTMENT OF B.A.,LL.B(HONS.)

The Department of B.A., LL.B (Hons.), the first department established under the School of Excellence in Law in 1997 at Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, is a pioneer in interdisciplinary legal education. Led by Dr. P. Vasantha Kumar, the programme aims to develop skilled and socially responsible legal professionals equipped to face global socio-legal and human rights challenges. It blends Arts and Social Sciences with core legal studies, offering a holistic understanding of law and society. Based on Outcome-Based Education (OBE), the curriculum emphasizes practical learning through moot courts, legal aid clinics, research, and field visits. The Department also conducts seminars, lectures, and awareness programmes while collaborating with leading institutions and NGOs to enhance research and internship opportunities. Its graduates contribute significantly to the judiciary, civil services, corporate law, academia, and international organizations.

THEME

Human Rights 2.0: Contemporary Challenges in the Digital Regime foregrounds how emerging technologies reshape access to justice, privacy, expression and equality. The theme invites contributions that move beyond technical critique to examine how law and institutions must adapt to preserve human dignity in contexts such as algorithmic decision-making, platform governance, surveillance, digital labour and synthetic media. By treating “2.0” as both a diagnostic and a call to reform, the conference prioritizes interdisciplinary approaches that combine legal reasoning with insights from technology studies, social policy and human rights practice.

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, School of Excellence in Law, through its B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) programme and Department of Human Rights, presents a one-day international conference designed to interrogate the human rights implications of rapid digital transformation. Scheduled for 30 January 2026, the conference brings together scholars, practitioners, policymakers and students to exchange rigorous, solution-oriented scholarship and to chart socio-legal responses that protect rights, dignity and democratic values in a technology-driven age. This convening is intended as a collaborative space where empirical insight and doctrinal analysis inform practicable recommendations for law, policy and institutional reform.

OBJECTIVES

The conference aims to provide a high-quality forum for critical discussion on socio-legal issues arising from digitization of public and private life; encourage and showcase student and faculty research that offers original analysis and constructive policy prescriptions; attract contributions from national and international experts to foster comparative learning and normative debate; publish selected papers to ensure the conference contributes enduring academic value; and stimulate practical pathways for strengthening accountability, inclusion and ethical governance in the digital ecosystem. These objectives are oriented toward producing scholarship that is both intellectually robust and practically relevant.

MODE OF SEMINAR

The conference will be held in a hybrid format, combining an in-person programme with live online sessions to ensure wider participation. Presenters may choose to deliver their papers on-site or virtually. All accepted abstracts must complete registration and follow the organisers' submission guidelines. E-certificates will be issued to online presenters, and selected papers may be published in the conference proceedings. Please note that accommodation is not provided, though assistance with local lodging information will be available on request.

THEMATIC AREAS FOR PRESENTATION

- 1. Transparency and accountability Risk in AI, Robotics and Algorithmic governance.**
- 2. Protecting Identity - Addressing Misrepresentation, Facial Recognition, Neurotechnology, and Biotechnological Risks.**
- 3. Digital Trade and Data Sovereignty; Human Rights in the Global Digital Economy.**
- 4. Artificial intelligence: balancing innovation with accountability**
- 5. Autonomous Warfare and Its relevance to International Humanitarian Law.**
- 6. Balancing right to freedom, privacy, and memory in the digital era amidst growing state access to personal data.**
- 7. Deepfakes, virtual realities, and digital abuse — redefining consent and protection.**
- 8. Authoritarian Digital Control: Internet shutdowns as tools of repression and Human rights suppression.**
- 9. Updating human rights law to combat digital forced labour in the age of Generative AI.**
- 10. Global Threats and Human Rights — Addressing Terrorism, Cyber Warfare, and Espionage in a Connected World.**

Note : The above-mentioned sub-themes are not exhaustive, the author may choose any other theme, however the same shall not be in derogation of the primary theme of the Conference.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- The abstract should be approximately 300 words, including five key words.
- Each abstract must be accompanied by the author's name, email ID, contact number, name of the institution , designation, and official address.
- The authors will have to mention the sub-theme to which their paper belongs.

(For both abstract and full paper)

- Font: Times New Roman
- Font Size: 12
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- Alignment: Justified
- Margins: 1 inch on all four sides
- Paper Size: A4
- File Format: MS Word (.doc/.docx) only
- Citation format : Bluebook 21st edition
- A maximum of three authors are permitted per paper.
- The word limit for the full paper, including the abstract, is **4000–6000** words (excluding footnotes).

FILE NAMING CONVENTION:

The file name should follow this format:

For co-authored papers, include only the first author's name in the file name.
