1. Abstracts: Abstracts shall be within the range of 300-350 words, with a minimum of 5 keywords (not counted in the word limit). To submit the abstract, kindly fill up the Google form:

2. Word Limit: Papers shall be in the length of 3000-5000 words. Detailed guidelines are as follows:

Author(s) should not mention their personal details at any places in the manuscript. Personal Details and Institutional Affiliations should be mentioned in a separate cover letter. The Cover Letter should have the Following Details:

- Name of all the Authors
- Email Address of all the Authors
- Contact Details of all the Authors
- Designation of all the Authors
- Institute Name of all the Authors
- Title of the Paper

2. **Word Limit:** The main body text in the manuscript must be in Times New Roman in a font size of 12, 1.5 line spacing and in Justified Alignment.

For footnotes, maintain Times New Roman Style with a font size of 10 and 1.0 line spacing.

For Headings, Times New Roman style must be followed with a font size of 14 and must be Bold.

Abstracts and manuscripts are to be submitted in .doc or .docx format only.

Participants are requested to only submit their Abstract initially.

Participants should follow the Bluebook 20th Edition for the purpose of Citing the Footnotes.

3. **Co- authorship:** Co- authorship up to 3 authors shall be permitted.
