## About the Fellowship Programme

The Jindal Global Law School, O.P. Jindal Global University, invites applications for the Academic Fellows position (2026–28). The two-year full-time Fellowship is designed for outstanding postgraduates in law and allied disciplines who are interested in pursuing careers in academia and research. The programme seeks to cultivate the next generation of scholars through intensive engagement with teaching, research, and institutional initiatives.

The Fellowship offers a unique opportunity to emerging and early career scholars to work closely with JGLS faculty across diverse areas of law and interdisciplinary research while gaining sustained exposure to pedagogy, curriculum design, training in legal and interdisciplinary methodology, research and writing mentorship, academic administration and policy engagement.



## A. About the Fellowship

The JGLS Academic Fellows position is envisioned as an immersive academic training and mentorship initiative, designed to cultivate the next generation of scholars, educators and policy thinkers. Fellows will actively contribute to the intellectual and institutional life of JGLS by supporting faculty-led teaching, research and related academic engagements while simultaneously developing their own academic and professional trajectories.

The Fellowship aims to:

- To create structured pathways into academic and research careers, enabling Fellows to transition into advanced roles in legal academia ;
- To promote foundational understating of research methods and academic writing, enabling Fellows to develop strong competencies in research design methodological rigour and scholarly expression.
- PTo provide structured mentorship in teaching and research through sustained faculty engagement aimed at strengthening pedagogical practices, equipping Fellows to effectively manage and deliver in classrooms
- To develop an understanding of institution building and governance, enabling Fellows to meaningfully engage with a administrative, academic, and organisational functions of the University.

## B. Key Responsibilities

### 1. Academic Support

- Assist faculty members in the delivery of undergraduate and postgraduate courses;
- Contribute to curriculum development and course administration
- Prepare teaching materials, reading lists, presentations and learning aids;
- Develop assignments and practice exercises;
- Assist in student engagement, tutorials and academic discussions;

### 2. Research and Publications

- Collaborate with faculty on research projects, publications, and policy interventions;
- Conduct literature reviews and doctrinal/interdisciplinary research;
- Assist with editing, cite-checking and manuscript preparation;
- Support research centres, journals and institutional academic initiatives;
- Contribute to conference reports, policy briefs and academic events;

### 3. Institutional Engagement

- Assist in workshops, conferences, seminars and executive education programmes;
- Support interdisciplinary initiatives across schools and centres at JGLS;
- Participate in institutional outreach and academic networking activities.

## C. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants should demonstrate:

- An outstanding academic record, advanced degree in LL.M or equivalent degree
- Strong research, writing and analytical skills;
- A demonstrated interest in academia, research and public policy; and
- The ability to work collaboratively in a dynamic academic environment.

The programme is particularly suited for:

- Recent graduates in law, social sciences, humanities or allied disciplines;
- Candidates pursuing or completing postgraduate degrees;
- Early-career professionals seeking to transition into academia or policy research;
- Practitioners and researchers interested in an academic sabbatical or interdisciplinary engagement.

Prior experience in research assistance, publications, mooting, editorial work, policy engagement, or teaching assistance will be an advantage.

#### **D. Duration and Nature of Appointment**

- Duration: Two Years (1+1) (2026–2028)
- Nature of Appointment: Full-Time, Contractual
- Location: JGLS Campus, Sonapat, Haryana
- Mode: In-Person (The Fellowship does not support remote or part-time engagement).
