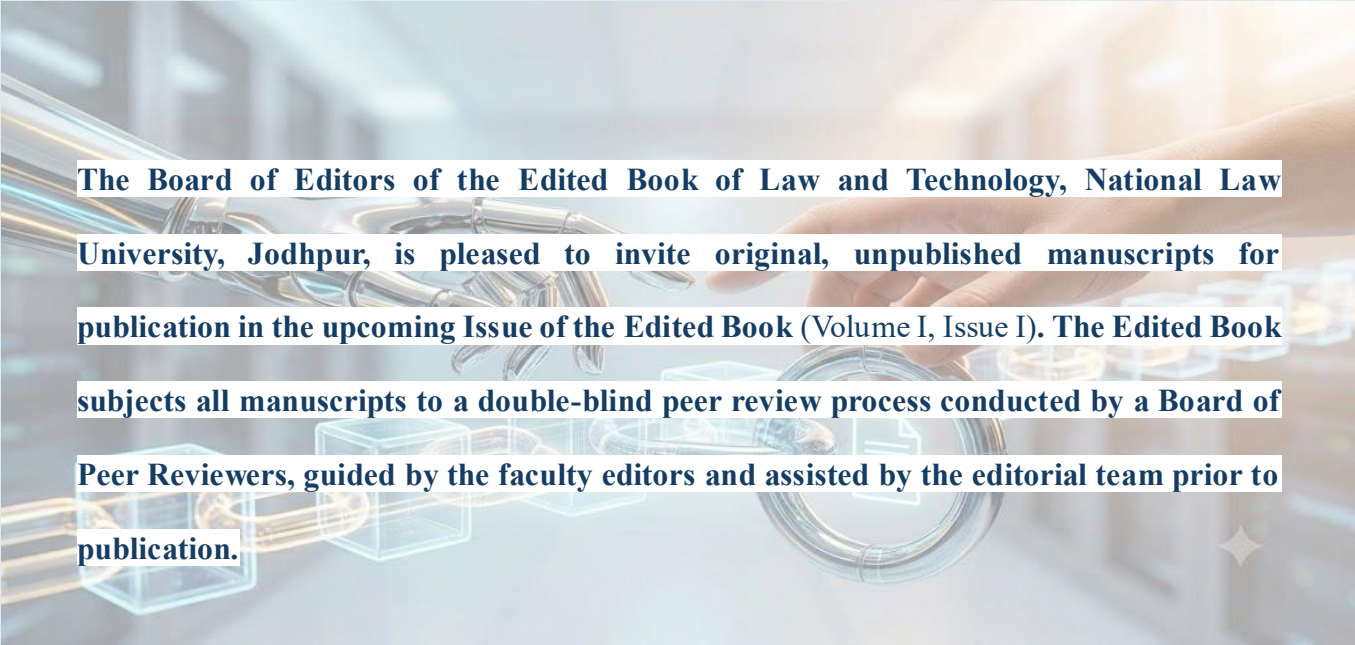

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Please note that submissions must conform to the following requirements:

1. **Word Limit:** 5,000- 6,000 words, inclusive of footnotes and abstract
2. All submissions must include an **Abstract** of not more than 300 words, along with 5–7 keywords
3. **Co-authorship:** Permitted, up to a maximum of three authors. Authors are permitted to send only one submission per author or a team of co-authors.
4. The manuscript should be on A4-sized paper and as per the formatting guidelines.
5. Language: **English only** (British or American spelling, used consistently).
6. **Footnotes** should be in Times New Roman, font size 10, with single line spacing.
7. The authors must conform to the **Bluebook (21th edition) Uniform System of Citation.**
8. **Similarity** up to **10%** is permissible. All submissions will be screened using Turnitin for similarity and AI generated content.
9. To ensure anonymous evaluation, the manuscript must not contain any identifying information relating to the author(s). Author information must be provided separately in a cover letter attached to the submission, with details as mentioned.

The following details:

- i. Name(s) of the author(s)
 - ii. Institutional affiliation(s)
 - iii. Contact Number and E-mail ID
 - iv. Postal Address
 - v. ORCID ID (if applicable) and
 - vi. A short biography of not more than 50 words
10. **Note:** Submissions must be original, unpublished and not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
11. Manuscripts not in conformity with the submission guidelines may be rejected at the sole discretion of the Editorial Board. The Editorial Board reserves the right to send the manuscripts back to the authors for any modification(s) at any stage, in the event of non-conformity with any of the submission guidelines.

FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Title: Times New Roman, size 15, bold, 2.0-line spacing, centre-aligned
2. Abstract: Times New Roman, size 12, italicized, 1.5-line spacing, justified, 2.0 margins
3. Main Body: Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5-line spacing, justified
4. Headings: Times New Roman, size 14, 1.5-line spacing, centre-aligned
5. Sub-headings: Times New Roman, size 13, italicized, 1.5-line spacing, centre-aligned
6. Footnotes: Times New Roman, size 10, 1.0-line spacing, justified
7. Margins: One inch (2.54 cm) on all sides

- Selected paper will be published as chapters in an accredited book bearing an ISBN.

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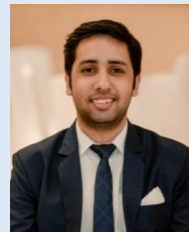
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
